A BILL FOR

An Act to require licensing of mining operators, to regulate surface mining, and relating to rehabilitation of land affected by surface mining.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

This is a Companion Bill; for complete text see House File 202.

- 1 Amend Senate File 279 as follows:
- 2 1. Amend Section 23 (twenty-three) by inserting after the
- 3 period in line 26 (twenty-six) the following:
- 4 "Any corporation that has engaged in business for five (5)
- 5 consecutive years preceding the date on which it registers
- 6 a site, is authorized to do business in the state of Iowa,
- 7 and annually submits a certified financial statement to the
- 8 department showing its net worth to be in excess of one mil-
- 9 lion dollars (\$1,000,000), shall not be required to have a
- 10 corporate surety on its bond, nor shall it be required to
- 11 furnish cash or other security. The establishment of finan-
- 12 cial responsibility in this manner shall not, however, re-
- 13 lieve the corporation of any other obligations imposed by
- 14 this Act."
