## A BILL FOR

An Act to provide for the use of safety emblems on slow moving vehicles.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Chapter three hundred twenty-one (321), Code  
2 1966, is amended by adding the following thereto:

3 "When operated on the highway, every implement of  
4 husbandry and any other vehicle with a maximum potential  
5 speed of twenty-five (25) miles per hour or less, may be  
6 identified with a reflective device of a standard type  
7 approved by the commissioner. No vehicle other than those  
8 specified in this section shall display reflective device  
9 approved for the use herein described."

1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twenty-one point four  
2 hundred twenty-three (321.423), subsection one (1), Code  
3 1966, is hereby amended by striking the period (.) and  
4 adding the following thereto:

5 ", and except on implements of husbandry and any other  
6 vehicle with a maximum potential speed of twenty-five (25)  
7 miles per hour or less."

- 1 Amend Senate File 306 by adding the following new section:
- 2 Sec. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions of
- 3 this act shall be fined not more than five dollars.

7 ment of husbandry, road construction or maintenance vehicle,  
8 road grader, and any other vehicle principally designed for  
9 use off the highway which, when operated on the highway, is  
10 operated on the highway at a speed of twenty-five (25) miles  
11 an hour or less, may be identified with a reflective device  
12 of a type and in a position of mounting on the vehicle as  
13 approved by the commissioner. The commissioner in his  
14 approval shall be guided as far as practicable by the  
15 standards of the American society of agricultural engineers.  
16 No vehicle other than those specified in this section shall  
17 display a reflective device approved for the use herein  
18 described."
