A BILL FOR

An Act to increase the minimum sick leave for school employees.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred seventy-nine point forty
2 (279.40), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
3 1. By striking lines five (5) through ten (10) and
4 inserting in lieu thereof the following:
5 "1. The first year of employment..... 10 days.
6 2. The second year of employment..... 11 days.
7 3. The third year of employment..... 12 days.
8 4. The fourth year of employment..... 13 days.
9 5. The fifth year of employment..... 14 days.
10 6. The sixth and subsequent years of employment.. 15 days."
11 2. By striking from line fourteen (14) the word
12 "thirty-five" and inserting in lieu thereof the word
13 "ninety (90)".

1 Amend Senate File 33 by striking all following the
2 enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3 Section 1. Section two hundred seventy-nine point forty
4 (279.40), Code 1966, is hereby repealed.

5 Sec. 2. Chapter nineteen (19), Code 1966, is hereby
6 amended by adding thereto the following new section:

7 "The executive council for and on behalf of the state
8 of Iowa shall purchase group insurance to provide total dis-
9 ability benefits, except for any benefits arising out of or
10 connected with pregnancy, for each teacher under contract
11 with a public school district in the state of Iowa. The
12 contract will provide that if the teacher becomes totally
13 disabled and remains totally disabled for a period of three
14 days, he will be entitled to benefits commencing on the fourth
15 day at the rate of \$500 per month during the continuance of
16 disability for a period not to exceed three months. The
17 monthly income would cease on the date of retirement, the
18 date total disability ceased or the date of death. The amount
19 payable for a period of covered disability of less than a
20 month would be computed by multiplying the monthly income
21 by the number of days for which benefits are payable and
22 dividing by thirty. Total disability, for purpose of this
23 law, means the inability of the teacher due to bodily injury
24 or sickness or both to perform the duties expected of him as
25 a teacher, and the insurers will be entitled to proof of
26 total disability in accordance with the terms of its policy
27 before payment of any claim.

28 The executive council shall purchase such insurance
29 from the general fund and shall be entitled to receive on
30 or before August 1 of each year and from time to time there-
31 after all information from each school district necessary to
32 effectuate the coverage provided."

5 1966, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu
6 thereof:

7 "Each year a public school employee shall be granted by the
8 district in which employed a leave of absence for personal ill-
9 ness or injury with full pay for three (3) days for which no com-
10 pensation is payable under the insurance contract provided under
11 chapter nineteen (19) covering total disability benefits for
12 teachers under contract with a public school district of this
13 state. Such leave shall not be cumulative from year to year."
