# A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the promulgation, approval and filing of rules of administrative agencies and to make an appropriation therefor.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section seventeen A point one (17A.1), Code  
2 1966, is amended as follows:

3 1. Strike from subsection three (3), line three (3),  
4 the word "recession" and insert in lieu thereof the word  
5 "rescission".

6 2. Add at the end of line one (1) of subsection four  
7 (4) the words "an expiration date but".

1 Sec. 2. Section seventeen A point two (17A.2), Code 1966,  
2 is amended as follows:

3 1. Add in line eight (8) before the word "Members" the  
4 word "Required".

5 2. Strike from line ten (10) the word "biennial".

6 3. Insert in line ten (10) after the word "session" the  
7 words "in odd-numbered years".

8 4. Strike from line eleven (11) the word "two-year" and  
9 insert in lieu thereof the word "four-year".

10 5. Add at the end of line eleven (11) the words "of the  
11 years of their respective appointments;"

12 6. Strike all of lines twelve (12) and thirteen (13) and  
13 insert in lieu thereof the word "however,"

14 7. Insert in line sixteen (16) after the word "authority"  
15 the words "for the remainder of the term".

16 8. Add at the end of the section a new paragraph as follows:  
17 "Appointments effective May 1, 1967 shall be: In the senate,  
18 two (2) for four (4) years and one (1) for two (2) years and in  
19 the house of representatives, two (2) for two (2) years and one  
20 (1) for four (4) years."

1 Sec. 3. Section seventeen A point three (17A.3), Code 1966,  
2 is amended as follows:

3 1. Strike all of lines six (6), seven (7) and eight (8)  
4 and insert in lieu thereof the words "Tuesday of each month to  
5 review all".

6 2. Add at the end of said section as a new sentence "The  
7 Code editor, or one (1) or more persons from his office, shall  
8 act as secretary to the committee, or the committee may em-  
9 ploy a secretary."

1 Sec. 4. Section seventeen A point four (17A.4), Code 1966,  
2 is amended as follows:

3 1. Strike from line two (2) the word "thirty" and insert  
4 in lieu thereof the word "forty (40)".

5 2. Strike the last sentence and insert in lieu thereof as  
6 a new sentence "There is hereby appropriated from any money in  
7 the treasury, not otherwise appropriated, an amount sufficient  
8 to defray all expenses incurred in carrying out the provisions  
9 of this chapter."

1 Sec. 5. Section seventeen A point five (17A.5), Code 1966,  
2 is amended as follows:

3 1. Strike from line three (3) the words "a copy" and in-  
4 sert in lieu thereof the words "four (4) copies".

5 2. Strike from the end of said section the words "and  
6 shall submit six copies of such proposed rule to the chairman  
7 of the departmental rules review committee" and insert in  
8 lieu thereof the words "and submit a copy of each proposed  
9 rule to each member of the departmental rules review com-  
10 mittee at least ten (10) days prior to that scheduled meeting  
11 of the committee at which consideration is desired and one  
12 (1) copy to the Code editor".

1     Sec. 6. Section seventeen A point six (17A.6), Code 1966,  
2 is amended as follows:

3     1. Strike from lines one (1) and two (2) the words "Within  
4 sixty days after receiving such copy" and insert in lieu  
5 thereof the words "Within thirty (30) days after receiving  
6 such copies".

7     2. Strike from lines six (6) and seven (7) the words  
8 "sixty days after receiving such copy" and insert in lieu  
9 thereof the words "thirty (30) days after receiving such copies".

1     Sec. 7. Section seventeen A point seven (17A.7), Code 1966,  
2 is amended by striking from line eleven (11) the word "sixty-  
3 five" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "forty-five (45)".

4     Further amend said section by adding at the end thereof  
5 the words ", except that postponement of action on any rule,  
6 after consideration by the committee at any meeting, shall  
7 toll the limitation of the statute and the committee's secre-  
8 tary shall report such fact to the agency submitting the  
9 rules".

1     Sec. 8. Section seventeen A point eight (17A.8), Code  
2 1966, is amended as follows:

3     1. Strike all of lines three (3) to twelve (12), inclusive.

4     2. Strike lines thirteen (13) to sixteen (16), inclusive,  
5 and insert in lieu thereof the words "There shall be endorsed  
6 on each copy of any proposed rule, (1) the attorney general's  
7 approval rendered pursuant to this chapter, if he so approves,  
8 or a statement that the pro-".

9     3. Strike from line twenty (20) the word "sixty" and insert  
10 in lieu thereof the word "thirty (30)".

11    4. Strike from lines twenty-four (24) and twenty-five (25)  
12 the words "chairman of the".

13    5. Insert in line twenty-seven (27) after the word "finding"  
14 the words "or postponement".

15    6. Strike from line twenty-eight (28) the word "sixty-five"  
16 and insert in lieu thereof the word "forty-five (45)".

17    7. Insert after line twenty-eight (28) new paragraphs as

18 follows:

19 "The secretary of state shall refuse to file any rule not  
20 endorsed as required by this section or prepared in form pre-  
21 scribed by section fourteen point three (14.3), subsection  
22 eight (8).

23 "All rules, temporary or permanent, shall become effective  
24 thirty (30) days after filing with the secretary of state,  
25 but another date may be specified not prior to the filing  
26 date."

27 8. Strike the first sentence from the paragraph beginning  
28 at line twenty-nine (29).

1 Sec. 9. Section seventeen A point ten (17A.10), Code 1966,  
2 is amended by striking from line one (1) the word "hereafter".

1 Amend Senate File 348 by adding the following new section:  
2 "Sec. 10. This Act, deemed of immediate importance shall  
3 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and pub-  
4 lication as provided by law, in the Fairfield Daily Ledger, a  
5 newspaper published at Fairfield, Iowa, and in The Clayton  
6 County Register, a newspaper at Elkader, Iowa."
