A BILL FOR

An Act to enable cities and towns to finance local citizens' committees on alcoholism payable from the amount of the liquor control fund distributed to cities and towns.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred twenty-three point fifty
2 (123.50), subsection three (3), Code 1966, is amended by
3 adding the following:

4 "It is hereby deemed a lawful municipal purpose for cities
5 and towns to allocate a portion of the above funds for the
6 purpose of financing the activities of a city or town
7 commission or committee on alcoholism, such commission or
8 committee to be appointed by the mayor and/or by the council.
9 The commission or committee may use any funds so allocated
10 to rehabilitate and educate alcoholics in Iowa."
