An Act relating to the licensing of feeder pig dealers.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The title of section one hundred sixty-three  
2 point thirty (163.30), Code 1966, is hereby stricken and the  
3 following inserted in lieu thereof: "Feeder pig dealers".

1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred sixty-three point thirty  
2 (163.30) subsection one (1), Code 1966, is hereby amended  
3 by striking from lines six (6) and seven (7) the words  
4 "employees of a licensed pig dealer doing business in the  
5 name of such dealer, or".

1 Sec. 3. Section one hundred sixty-three point thirty  
2 (163.30) subsection two (2), Code 1966, is hereby amended by  
3 adding in line seventeen (17) after the word "Act.":

4 "Employees or agents doing business by buying for resale,  
5 selling or exchanging feeder swine in the name of the  
6 licensed dealer, shall be required to secure a permit and  
7 identification card issued by the department showing they are  
8 employed by a licensed dealer. All permits and identification  
9 certificates shall be issued upon application forms furnished  
10 by the department at a cost of three (3) dollars per annum  
11 and shall expire on the first day of July following the date  
12 of issue."

1 Sec. 4. Section one hundred sixty-three point thirty  
2 (163.30) subsection three (3), Code 1966, is hereby amended  
3 by adding to line seventeen (17) after the word "certificate.":

4 "All native Iowa swine that are purchased for further

5 resale as feeders, except as slaughter animals or for the  
6 production of biological products, shall be individually ear  
7 tagged with an approved Iowa swine tag, affixed to either ear,  
8 at the time of purchase by the purchaser before leaving the  
9 premises of the seller, or by the purchaser prior to leaving  
10 the premises of the livestock market from which they were  
11 consigned for sale, or such swine may move from a farm of  
12 origin to a state-federal approved market, approved to handle  
13 swine where the purchaser shall affix a swine tag. The  
14 attached swine ear tag numbers shall be recorded in series  
15 inclusive for each separate lot of swine on the appropriate  
16 certificates and such certificates must accompany the swine  
17 from the premises of the seller or livestock market. A record  
18 shall be kept by the purchaser, seller, or the approved market  
19 if consigned there for sale, of the number on the attached swine  
20 ear tags. These records shall be made available to any state  
21 inspector."

1 Sec. 5. Section one hundred sixty-three point thirty  
2 (160.30) subsection five (5), Code 1966, is hereby amended by  
3 adding the following:

4 "In a hardship case the department may issue a permit to  
5 extend the time limit on movement of swine."

1 Sec. 6. Section one hundred sixty-three point thirty  
2 (163.30) subsection seven (7), Code 1966, is hereby amended by  
3 striking lines fourteen (14) through sixteen (16).
