A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the use of flashing lights on slow-moving vehicles.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point four
 2 hundred twenty-three (321.423), Code 1966, is hereby amended
 3 by adding thereto the following new subsection:
 4 "Any implement of husbandry or other farm vehicle which
 5 has a maximum speed of less than twenty-five (25) miles per
 6 hour may be equipped with and display a flashing light. The
 7 type, color, and dimensions of the light shall be approved by
 8 the commissioner. The flashing light shall be mounted on the
 9 rear of the vehicle and shall be not less than three (3)
 10 feet nor more than five (5) feet above the ground."

1 1. Amend Section 1, line 4, by inserting after the
 2 word "Any" the words "self propelled".
 3 2. Amend Sec. 1, line 4, by striking the word "farm".
 4 3. Amend Sec. 1, line 6, by striking the word "a" and
 5 inserting in lieu thereof the words "not more than two", and
 6 by striking the word "light" and inserting in lieu thereof
 7 the word "lights".
 8 4. Amend Sec. 1, line 8, by inserting after the word
 9 "light" the words "or lights".
 10 5. Amend Sec. 1, by striking all after the word "mounted"
 11 in line 8 and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "in
 12 such a manner as to be visible from the front and rear."

3 in lieu thereof: "The flashing light shall be amber in color,
4 non-glare, discernible from all directions, and shall diffuse
5 a non-glare white light downward for visual identification.
6 The light shall be mounted so as to be adjustable in height.
7 The detailed specification, design, and exact mounting of
8 the light shall be subject to approval by the commissioner."
