## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to social science subject requirements under minimum school standards.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred fifty-seven point twenty-  
2 five (257.25), Code 1966, is amended by inserting in line  
3 ten (10) of subsection six (6), immediately following the  
4 word "economics.", the words "The requirements in any of  
5 said specified social science subjects may be satisfied by  
6 a minimum of one-half (1/2) unit of instruction."

1 Amend Senate File 379 by striking all after the  
2 enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the  
3 following:  
4 Section 1. Section two hundred fifty-seven point  
5 twenty-five (257.25), subsection six (6), Code 1966,  
6 is hereby amended by striking therefrom paragraph b  
7 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
8 "Four units of the social studies. Instruction in  
9 American history, American government, and economics  
10 shall be included in said units but need not be  
11 required as full units."  
12 Amend the title to Senate File 379 by striking all  
13 after the word "relating" and inserting in lieu thereof  
14 the following: "to educational standards."
