## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to payments to nursing homes and custodial homes.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Chapter two hundred forty-one (241), Code 1966,  
2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:  
3 "If the state board is making direct assistance payments to  
4 persons providing a recipient with custodial and nursing home  
5 service in amounts less than the usual and reasonable charge  
6 for such service, the state board shall permit the recipient  
7 or someone on his behalf to pay the person rendering the  
8 service the difference between the amount of assistance and  
9 the reasonable value of such service, without deducting such  
10 additional payment from the direct assistance payment to be  
11 made by the state board."

1 Sec. 2. Chapter two hundred forty-one A (241A), Code 1966,  
2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:  
3 "If the state board is making direct assistance payments  
4 to persons providing a recipient with custodial and nursing  
5 home service in amounts less than the usual and reasonable  
6 charge for such service, the state board shall permit the  
7 recipient or someone on his behalf to pay the person  
8 rendering the service the difference between the amount of  
9 assistance and the reasonable value of such service, without  
10 deducting such additional payment from the direct assistance  
11 payment to be made by the state board."

2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:  
3     "If the state board is making direct assistance payments  
4 to persons providing a recipient with custodial and nursing  
5 home service in amounts less than the usual and reasonable  
6 charge for such service, the state board shall permit the  
7 recipient or someone on his behalf to pay the person rendering  
8 the service the difference between the amount of assistance  
9 and the reasonable value of such service, without deducting  
10 such additional payment from the direct assistance payment  
11 to be made by the state board."

1     Sec. 4. Chapter two hundred forty-nine A (249A), Code 1966,  
2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:  
3     "If the state board is making direct assistance payments  
4 to persons providing a recipient with custodial and nursing  
5 home service in amounts less than the usual and reasonable charge  
6 for such service, the state board shall permit the recipient or  
7 someone on his behalf to pay the person rendering the service  
8 the difference between the amount of assistance and the  
9 reasonable value of such service, without deducting such  
10 additional payment from the direct assistance payment to be  
11 made by the state board."

1     Sec. 5. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,  
2 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication  
3 in the Lake Mills Graphic, a newspaper published in Lake Mills,  
4 Iowa, and in The Northwood Anchor, a newspaper published in  
5 Northwood, Iowa.
