## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the military forces of the state of Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section twenty-nine A point sixteen (29A.16),  
2 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By striking lines one (1) through four (4) and insert-  
4 ing in lieu thereof the following:

5 "The governor shall appoint a deputy adjutant general, who  
6 shall be a commissioned officer of the army national guard or  
7 the air national guard, and an assistant adjutant general for  
8 the army national guard who shall be a commissioned officer  
9 of the army national guard, and an assistant adjutant general  
10 for the air national guard who shall be a commissioned officer  
11 of the air national guard, upon the recommendation of the  
12 adjutant gen-".

13 2. By striking from line five (5) the word "He" and insert-  
14 ing in lieu thereof the word "They".

15 3. By striking from line eight (8) the words "his appoint-  
16 ment shall be a" and inserting in lieu thereof the words  
17 "their appointment shall be".

18 4. By striking from line nine (9) the words "officer of  
19 the air" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "officers of  
20 the".

21 5. By striking from line ten (10) the words "or army na-  
22 tional guard".

23 6. By striking from line fourteen (14) the word "he" and  
24 inserting in lieu thereof the word "they".

25 7. By striking from line fifteen (15) the words "captain.  
26 He" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "a field officer.  
27 They".

28 8. By striking from line sixteen (16) the word "his" and  
29 inserting in lieu thereof the word "their".

30 9. By striking from line eighteen (18) the word "assis-  
31 tant" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "deputy".

32 10. By adding thereto the following new sentence:

33 "Each assistant adjutant general shall be responsible for  
34 such duties with the army national guard or the air national  
35 guard, respectively, as may be prescribed by the adjutant  
36 general".

1 Sec. 2. Section twenty-nine A point twenty-three (29A.23),  
2 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By striking lines four (4) through ten (10) and insert-  
4 ing in lieu thereof the following:

5 "ten (10) years in the national guard, who re-".

6 2. By striking from lines twelve (12), thirteen (13) and  
7 fourteen (14) the following:

8 ", upon his request in writing to the adjutant general,  
9 stating his grounds therefor,".

10 3. By inserting in line twenty-five (25) after the word  
11 "provided," the following:

12 "who shall have served as such officer for a period of not  
13 less than twenty (20) years in the national guard, or in the  
14 active military service of the United States, and who shall  
15 have served as such officer in the national guard for not less  
16 than ten (10) years".

17 4. By adding thereto the following new sentence:

18 "Service in the inactive national guard shall not be credit-  
19 able toward the service requirement provided in this section".

1 Sec. 3. Section twenty-nine A point fifty-seven (29A.57),

2 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By striking from line thirteen (13) the words "Civilian  
4 members" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "Members".

5 2. By striking from line fourteen (14) the word "ten" and  
6 inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty (30)".

1 Sec. 4. Chapter twenty-nine A (29A), Code 1966, is hereby  
2 amended by adding thereto the following new section:

3 "A member of the Iowa national guard, who was not retired,  
4 and was otherwise qualified for any state service award or for  
5 state appointment or promotion to a higher grade or rank as  
6 provided in this chapter, and who was unable to receive such  
7 award or appointment or promotion by reason of death, is eli-  
8 gible for posthumous grant of the award of state appointment  
9 or promotion to a higher grade or rank. The adjutant general  
10 shall present the award or evidence of the state appointment  
11 or promotion to the next of kin of the deceased member."

1 Amend Senate File 691 as follows:

2 By striking all of section 2 (sec. 2) and renumbering  
3 the remaining sections.
