A BILL FOR

An Act relating to barbering.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred fifty-eight point eleven
2 (158.11), Code 1966, is hereby amended by inserting after
3 line nine (9) the following new paragraph:

4 "In each private school or college of barbering, there
5 shall be at least two (2) registered instructors for every
6 thirty (30) students or fraction thereof, and one (1) additional
7 instructor for each additional fifteen (15) students or fraction
8 thereof. Instructors shall devote their entire time during
9 school hours to the instruction and supervision of student
10 work and shall not apply time during such hours to the private
11 or public practice of barbering for any reason."

- 1 Amend Senate File 728 by adding the following
- 2 new section:
- 3 Any increase in the price of individual haircuts
- 4 in the State of Iowa shall first require approval
- 5 of the General Assembly of the State of Iowa.
