A BILL FOR

An Act authorizing school corporations to use the proceeds of the sale of college buildings and other related property to pay the cost of additional school facilities.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Irrespective of the provisions of chapter two
 2 hundred ninety-seven (297) of the Code, any school corporation
 3 which has heretofore sold or may hereafter sell any public
 4 community or junior college building, buildings, or other
 5 related property, whether under the provisions of chapter
 6 two hundred eighty A (280A) of the Code or otherwise, is
 7 hereby authorized to use the proceeds of such sale to pay
 8 all or any part of the cost of building, furnishing, recon-
 9 structing, repairing, improving, or remodeling a schoolhouse
 10 or schoolhouses, or additions thereto, or for procuring a
 11 site or sites therefor, or any combination thereof, even
 12 though all of the bonds which may have been issued by such
 13 school corporation to pay the cost of the building, buildings
 14 or property sold have not been paid and retired; provided,
 15 however, that the proposition of using the money derived from
 16 such sale for any one or more of the foregoing purposes shall
 17 first be submitted to and approved by the voters of the
 18 school corporation at an election called and held in the
 19 manner hereinafter provided. The election may be called by
 20 the board of directors of the school corporation on its own
 21 motion, and notice of the election shall be published once
 22 each week for four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper pub-
 23 lished in the school corporation, or if there is none, in a

24 newspaper published in the county and of general circulation
25 in the school corporation. The election shall be held on a day
26 not less than five (5) nor more than twenty (20) days after the
27 last publication of the notice. The preparation of the ballot,
28 the appointment of election officials, and other details of
29 the election shall be governed by the statutory provisions other-
30 wise applicable to regular school elections. No such proposi-
31 tion shall be declared carried unless the affirmative vote is
32 equal to at least sixty (60) percent of the total vote cast
33 for and against the proposition at the election.
