A BILL FOR

Conference Committee

An Act relating to disaster aid for governmental subdivisions.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section nineteen point seven (19.7), Code 1966,
2 is hereby amended by deleting from lines nine (9) and ten (10)
3 thereof the words "and for no other purpose whatever." and
4 inserting the following:

5 "and for aid to any local government in an area declared
6 by the governor to be a disaster area due either to natural
7 or man-made disasters or to expenditures necessitated by the
8 local government toward averting or lessening the impact of
9 potential disaster, where the effect of such disaster or
10 such action on the municipality is the immediate financial
11 inability to meet the continuing requirements of local govern-
12 ment. Upon application therefor by a local government in such
13 an area, accompanied by a showing of obligations and expendi-
14 tures necessitated by such actual or potential disaster, in
15 such form and with such further information as the executive
16 council may require, such aid may take one (1) or more of
17 the following forms:

18 1. A loan without interest, which shall be repaid by an
19 annual emergency levy as authorized by section twenty-four
20 point six (24.6) of the Code.

21 2. A grant in aid up to fifty (50) percent of the costs
22 and obligations incurred by such municipality in combating,
23 averting, or lessening the effect of such disaster, not to

24 exceed one hundred thousand (100,000) dollars.

25 The proceeds of such loan or grant shall be applied toward
26 the payment of costs and obligations necessitated by such
27 actual or potential disaster and the reimbursement of local
28 funds from which such expenditures have been made."

1 Sec. 2. Section four hundred four point nineteen (404.19),
2 Code 1966, is hereby amended by inserting in line eleven (11)
3 after the word "to" the following:

4 "loans and matching grants obtained from the state in com-
5 bating, averting, or lessening the effect of natural or man-
6 made disasters, and except as further provided in the law
7 relating to".

TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

We, the undersigned members of the Conference Committee appointed to consider the difference between the Senate and the House of Representatives on Senate File 796, and Act relating to disaster aid for governmental subdivisions, beg leave to report and make the following recommendations:

1. Amend Senate File 796 by inserting as Section 1, and renumbering the remaining sections accordingly, the following:

~~Section 1. For the purposes of this Act, 'governmental subdivision' means a city, town, county, or school district.~~

2. Amend Section 1 by striking from line five (5) the words "local government" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "governmental subdivision".

3. Further amend Section 1 by striking from line eight (8) the words "local government" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "governmental subdivision".

4. Further amend Section 1 by striking from line ten (10) the word "municipality" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "governmental subdivision".

5. Further amend Section 1 by striking from line twelve (12) the words "local government" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "governmental subdivision".

6. Further amend Section 1 by inserting in line 19 after the words "Said loan" the words ", without interest,".
