A BILL FOR

An Act relating to acceptance of federal funds for highway safety.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter seven (7), Code 1966, is hereby amended
2 by adding thereto the following:

3 "The governor, in addition to other duties and responsibilities
4 conferred upon him by the constitution and laws of this state,
5 is hereby empowered to contract and to do all other things neces-
6 sary to secure the full benefits available to this state under
7 the federal highway safety act of 1966, and in so doing, to
8 cooperate with federal and state agencies, private and public
9 organizations, and with individuals, to effectuate the purpose
10 of that enactment, and any and all subsequent amendments thereto.
11 The governor shall be responsible for and is hereby empowered
12 to administer through such appropriate agency of this state
13 as he shall designate within thirty (30) days from the date
14 hereof, the highway safety programs of this state and those of
15 its political subdivisions, all in accordance with said act and
16 federal rules and regulations in implementation thereof."

1 Amend Senate File 820 by striking from section one (1)
2 lines thirteen (13) and fourteen (14) the words "the date
3 hereof" and inserting in lieu thereof "July 1, 1967".

1 Amend Senate File 820 as follows:

2 1. Section 1, by striking all of lines three (3)
3 through sixteen (16) and inserting in lieu thereof the
4 following:

5 "The governor, in addition to other duties and
6 responsibilities conferred upon him by the constitution
7 and laws of this state, is hereby empowered to contract
8 for the benefits available to this state under the
9 federal highway safety act of 1966 as specifically set
10 out in the national standards announced June 27, 1967
11 by the federal secretary of transportation, and in so
12 doing, to cooperate with federal and state agencies,
13 private and public organizations, and with individuals,
14 to effectuate the purpose of that enactment. The
15 governor shall be responsible for and is hereby
16 empowered to administer through the department of public
17 safety or through the highway commission or both, the
18 highway safety programs of this state and those of its
19 political subdivisions, all in accordance with said act
20 and the constitution of the state of Iowa, in
21 implementation thereof."

22 2. By adding the following section:

23 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
24 ~~shall take effect after its passage, approval and~~
25 ~~publication in the Bettendorf News, a newspaper published~~
26 at Bettendorf, Iowa, and in The Woodbine Twiner a
27 newspaper published at Woodbine, Iowa.
