An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the Iowa state arts council the sum of fifty thousand (50,000) dollars for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending June 30, 1969.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
2 fund of the state of Iowa to the Iowa state arts council for
3 each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1967 and ending
4 June 30, 1969, the sum of fifty thousand (50,000) dollars,
5 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the
6 following manner:

7 For salaries, support, maintenance, and
8 miscellaneous purposes \$50,000.00

9 Grand total of all appropriations for all
10 purposes for each year of the biennium for the
11 Iowa state arts council. \$50,000.00

1 Sec. 2. Any unencumbered balance of the funds appropriated
2 by this Act remaining as of June 30, 1969 shall revert to the
3 general fund of the state on that date.
