A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to municipal lighting districts.
- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 3 Section 1. Section three hundred eighty-nine point seventeen
- 4 (389.17), Code 1966, is amended by striking from line two (2)
- 5 the word "fifteen" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "ten".

EXPLANATION

Presently, only cities with a population of 15,000 or more may establish lighting districts and assess a special tax not to exceed one-half mill to pay for the project. This bill provides that all cities with a population of 10,000 or more may establish lighting districts.

- 1 Amend House File 1007 as follows:
- 2 1. By striking from page 1 all of lines 4 and 5 and
- 3 inserting in lieu thereof the following: "(389.17), Code
- 4 1966, is amended by striking from lines one (1) and two (2)
- 5 the words 'city of fifteen thousand or more population,'
- 6 and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'city or town'".
- 7 2. By adding to Section 1 the following:
- 8 "Said section is further amended by inserting after
- 9 the word 'city' in lines four (4), five (5), six (6), and
- 10 twelve (12) the words 'or town' in each instance."
- 11 3. By adding the following new section:
- 12 "Sec. 2. Section three hundred eighty-nine point
- 13 eighteen (389.18), Code 1966, is amended by inserting in
- 14 line two (2) and three (3) after the word 'city' the
- 15 words 'or town' in each instance."
