A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the legislative members of the Higher Educa-
2 tion Facilities Commission.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. Section two hundred sixty-one point one (261.1),
5 Code 1966, is amended by striking from subsection four (4) as
6 amended by Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly, chapter
7 two hundred thirty-two (232), section one (1), subsection one
8 (1), the words "A member of the senate to be appointed by the
9 lieutenant governor who shall serve for a term of two years.

10 Any appointment prior to June 30, 1967 shall terminate on that
11 date and any member appointed for a term thereafter, except to
12 fill a vacancy, shall be for four (4) years." and inserting in
13 lieu thereof the words "A member of the senate to be appointed
14 by the president of the senate for a term of four years begin-
15 ning on July 1 of the year of appointment."

16 Further amend said section by striking from subsection five
17 (5) as amended by chapter two hundred thirty-two (232), section
18 one (1), subsection two (2), the words "A member of the house
19 of representatives to be appointed by the speaker of the house
20 who shall serve for a term of two years. Any appointment prior
21 to June 30, 1969 shall terminate on that date and any member
22 appointed for a term thereafter, except to fill a vacancy, shall
23 serve for four (4) years." and inserting in lieu thereof the
24 words "A member of the house of representatives to be appointed
25 by the speaker of the house for a term of four years beginning

- 1 on July 1 of the year of appointment.”
- 2 Sec. 2. This Act shall not operate to shorten the term of
- 3 any member serving on the date of its enactment.

EXPLANATION

This bill eliminates some obsolete language in the statutes providing for the appointment of legislative members of the Higher Education Facilities Commission but does not change the permanent provisions nor affect the terms of members now serving.
