- 1 An Act relating to the definition of alcoholic beverages for
- 2 liquor law-enforcement purposes.
- 3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 4 Section 1. Chapter two hundred five (205), Acts of the
- 5 Sixty-third General Assembly, First Session, is hereby amended
- 6 as follows:
- 7 1. By striking from section one (1), line six (6), the
- 8 words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu thereof
- 9 the word "alcohol".
- 10 2. By striking from section one (1), lines thirteen (13)
- 11 and fourteen (14), the words "an alcoholic beverage" and
- 12 inserting in lieu thereof the word "alcohol".
- 13 3. By striking from section one (1), line twenty-nine (29),
- 14 the words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu thereof
- 15 the word "alcohol".
- 16 4. By striking from section two (2), lines three (3) and
- 17 four (4), the words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in
- 18 lieu thereof the word "alcohol".
- 19 5. By striking from section three (3), line four (4), the
- 20 words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu thereof
- 21 the word "alcohol".
- 22 6. By striking from section four (4), line four (4), the
- 23 words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu thereof
- 24 the word "alcohol".
- 25 7. By striking from section five (5), line four (4), the

- 1 words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu thereof
2 the word "alcohol".
- 3 8. By striking from section six (6), lines four (4) and
4 five (5), the words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in
5 lieu thereof the word "alcohol".
- 6 9. By striking from section six (6), line eight (8), the
7 words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu thereof
8 the word "alcohol".
- 9 10. By striking from section six (6), line eleven (11),
10 the words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu there-
11 of the word "alcohol".
- 12 11. By striking from section seven (7), line five (5), the
13 words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu thereof
14 the word "alcohol".
- 15 12. By striking from section seven (7), line eight (8),
16 the words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu
17 thereof the word "alcohol".
- 18 13. By striking from section eight (8), line four (4), the
19 words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu thereof
20 the word "alcohol".
- 21 14. By striking from section nine (9), line four (4), the
22 words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu thereof
23 the word "alcohol".
- 24 15. By striking from section ten (10), line four (4), the
25 words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu thereof
26 the word "alcohol".
- 27 16. By striking from section eleven (11), line four (4),
28 the words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting in lieu there-
29 of the word "alcohol".
- 30 17. By striking from section twelve (12), lines three (3)
31 and four (4), the words "an alcoholic beverage" and inserting
32 in lieu thereof the word "alcohol".

EXPLANATION

The words "alcoholic beverage" have been replaced with the word "alcohol" in chapter 205 of the Acts of the Sixty-third General Assembly, First Session, in order to resolve a technical problem. Section 123.5(5) of the 1966 Iowa Code excepts beer from the definition of "alcoholic beverage". The unintended result might be construed to mean a person can become intoxicated on beer and not be "under the influence of an alcoholic beverage" according to the present law.
