## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to joint planning commissions.

2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

3 Section 1. Section four hundred seventy-three A point one  
4 (473A.1), Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding thereto the  
5 following new paragraph:

6 "The joint planning commission shall be separate and apart  
7 from the governmental units creating it, may sue and be sued,  
8 contract for the purchase and sale of real and personal prop-  
9 erty necessary for its purposes, and shall be a juristic  
10 entity as the term is used in section ninety-seven C point two  
11 (97C.2), subsection six (6), of the Code."

12 Sec. 2. Chapter one hundred twenty-one (121), section nine  
13 (9), Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly, amending sec-  
14 tion ninety-seven B point forty-one (97B.41), Code 1966, as  
15 amended by chapter one hundred six (106), section one (1),  
16 Acts of the Sixty-third General Assembly, First Session, is  
17 further amended by inserting in line thirty-eight (38) before  
18 the comma the words "including joint planning commissions  
19 created under the provisions of chapter four hundred seventy-  
20 three A (473A) of the Code".

This bill will bring employees of joint planning commissions under the benefits of the federal social security act and the Iowa Public Employees Retirement System.

Prepared in regard to House File 1098, a bill for an act relating to joint planning commissions.

Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal as required by Rule 31.

The following is the estimated cost to political subdivisions of the State of bringing employees of Joint Planning Commissions under the benefits of the federal social security act and the Iowa Public Employees Retirement System:

16 employees earning in excess of maximum withholding	
FICA	\$ 5,990.40
IPERS	3,920.00
7 employees earning an average of \$6,000 per year	
FICA	2,016.00
IPERS	1,470.00
<b>Total</b>	<b>\$13,396.40</b>

The above is the estimated annual cost based on the current number of employees of the Joint Planning Commissions. It is anticipated that the size of these staffs will increase which will increase the employers' contribution to these pension plans.
