A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the terms of office of the architectural
- 2 examining board.
- 3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 4 Section 1. Section one hundred eighteen point one (118.1),
- 5 Code 1966, is hereby amended by inserting in line ten (10)
- 6 after the period the following:
- 7 "Beginning July 1, 1971, the governor shall appoint one
- 8 member to the board for a two-year period and one member for a
- 9 three-year period. Beginning July 1, 1972, the governor shall
- 10 appoint one member to the board for a three-year period, one
- 11 member for a four-year period, and one member for a five-year
- 12 period."

EXPLANATION

Presently the terms of office of the Architectural Examiners Board are staggered so that two members' terms expire June 30, 1971, and three members' terms expire on June 30, 1972. The disruption of the board's activities caused by the expiration of terms in this manner is considerable. This bill, requested at the suggestion of the current board, establishes a temporary appointment procedure which will result in only one Board member's term expiring in any one year.
