A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to required eye safety equipment used in schools.

2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

3 Section 1. Section two hundred eighty point twenty (280.20),

4 Code 1966, as amended by chapter one hundred eighty-eight (188),

5 section one (1), Acts of the Sixty-third General Assembly, First

6 Session, is further amended as follows:

7 1. By striking from line two (2) the word "school" and in-
8 serting in lieu thereof the words "or private school, or college
9 or university".

10 2. By inserting in line twenty-five (25) after the period
11 the following sentence:

12 "Visitors to such shops and laboratories shall be furnished
13 with and required to wear the necessary safety devices while
14 such programs are in progress."

15 3. By inserting in line thirty-four (34) after the word
16 "education" the words "or governing agency".

EXPLANATION

This bill requires all schools to provide the necessary eyeprotective devices for students participating in certain courses and also for visitors in such shops and laboratories. Presently only public schools are required to provide this equipment.

1 Amend House File 1188 by adding the following new
2 subsection:

3 "4. By striking lines forty-five (45), forty-six (46),
4 forty-seven (47), and forty-eight (48), inclusive, and inserting
5 in lieu thereof the words "American National Standard Z87.1-1968,
6 Practice for Occupational and Educational Eye and Face Protection
7 promulgated by the American National Standards Institute, Inc."
