- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 3 Section 1. Section seventy-nine point one (79.1), Code
- 4 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
- 5 1. By striking from line fourteen (14) the word "tenth"
- 6 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifth".
- 7 2. By striking from line sixteen (16) the word "tenth"
- 8 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifth".
- 9 3. By striking from line thirty-nine (39) the word "two"
- 10 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "three".
- 11 4. By striking from line forty-one (41) the word "ninth"
- 12 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifth".
- 13 5. By striking from lines forty-two (42) and forty-three
- 14 (43) the words "three and three-fourths" and inserting in
- 15 lieu thereof the words "five and one-fourth".
- 16 6. By striking from line forty-four (44) the words "through
- 17 the tenth" and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "during
- 18 the sixth through the fifteenth and seven days pay for each
- 19 completed calendar quarter during the sixteenth".

EXPLANATION

This bill provides a new vacation schedule for state employees. It allows employees to receive two weeks vacation for the second through the fifth year of employment and three weeks vacation for the sixth through the fifteenth year of employment.

- 3 7. By striking from lines 11 and 12 the words "one week"
- 4 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "two weeks".
- 5 8. By striking in line sixteen (16) the word "fifteenth",
- 6 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "tenth".
- 7 9. By striking from line 18 the word "fifteenth" and
- 8 inserting in lieu thereof the word "tenth".

REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE (House File 1197)

To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House
 of Representatives:

We, the undersigned members of the conference committee appointed to consider the difference between the Senate and the House of Representatives on House File 1197, a bill for an Act relating to vacations for state employees, respectfully submit the following recommendations:

1. That the Senate recede from its amendments.
2. Amend House File 1197, page 1, as follows:
 1. By inserting after line 8 the following subsections:
 - a. "By striking from line sixteen (16) the word "fifteenth" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "twelfth".
 - b. "By striking from line eighteen (18) the word "fifteenth" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "twelfth".
 2. By renumbering the subsequent subsections.
 3. By striking from line 18 the word "fifteenth" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "twelfth".
 4. Line 19, by striking the word "sixteenth" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirteenth".
