## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to widows' admissions to the Iowa soldiers

2 home.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. Section two hundred nineteen point four (219.4),

5 Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking in lines three (3) and

6 four (4) the words "ten years" and inserting in lieu thereof

7 the words "one year".

8 Sec. 2. Section two hundred nineteen point five (219.5),

9 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

10 1. By striking in lines ten (10) and eleven (11) the words

11 "ten years" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "one year".

12 2. By striking in line seventeen (17) the word "ten" and

13 inserting in lieu thereof the word "three".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 129

This Act will relieve a small segment of widows from an unreasonable time requirement for admission to the Iowa soldiers home.

1 Amend the title to House File 129 by striking from line one (1)

2 the words "widows' admissions" and inserting in lieu thereof

3 "admission of widows and wives of members".
