EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 13

This bill establishes a "certainty and life thereafter" option for the payment of benefits under IPERS. The option guarantees that full benefits will be provided either the member, or in case of his death, his widow for a ten-year certainty period. No additional costs are anticipated to IPERS through implementation of this option.
