# A BILL FOR *aye 44, nays 0*

1 An Act relating to the issuance of bonds for dock purposes.

2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

3 Section 1. Section three hundred eighty-four point three  
4 (384.3), subsection eleven (11), Code 1966, as amended by  
5 chapter eighty-seven (87), Acts of the Sixty-third General  
6 Assembly, First Session, is hereby further amended by striking  
7 lines one (1) through seven (7), inclusive, and inserting  
8 in lieu thereof the following:

9 "Cities and towns are hereby authorized to contract  
10 indebtedness and to issue general obligation bonds to provide  
11 funds to pay the cost of acquiring, purchasing, constructing,  
12 reconstructing, equipping, improving, relocating, repairing  
13 or remodeling any of the works or improvements referred to  
14 in this chapter, including the grading and filling of lands  
15 and the acquisition of property of every kind and description,  
16 whether real, personal or mixed, which is useful in the opera-  
17 tion of dock facilities. Whenever the dock board deems it  
18 necessary or advisable to issue bonds for any one or more of  
19 the foregoing purposes, said board shall petition".

20 Sec. 2. Section three hundred ninety-four point two  
21 (394.2), Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking from line  
22 twenty-one (21) the words "such improvement" and inserting in  
23 lieu thereof the words "acquiring, purchasing, constructing,  
24 reconstructing, equipping, improving, relocating, repairing  
25 or remodeling any of the works or improvements referred to in

1 chapter three hundred eighty-four (384) of the Code including  
2 the grading and filling of lands and the acquisition of property  
3 of every kind and description, whether real, personal or mixed,  
4 which is useful in the operation of dock facilities."

5 Sec. 3. This Act being deemed of immediate importance  
6 shall be in full force and effect from and after its final  
7 approval and publication in The Daily Gate City, a newspaper  
8 published at Keokuk, Iowa, and The Clinton Herald, a newspaper  
9 published at Clinton, Iowa.

EXPLANATION

The purpose of this bill is to rewrite, clarify and expand the law authorizing cities and towns to issue bonds for financing municipal docks.
