A BILL FOR

1 An Act to make appropriations to the appointive members of the
2 capitol planning commission for per diem compensation for
3 services rendered.

4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

5 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
6 of the state to the following named persons the amounts set
7 opposite their respective names in full settlement of all per
8 diem claims they may have against the state for services rendered
9 as appointive members of the capitol planning commission in
10 accordance with chapter eighteen A (18A) of the Code:

18 Sec. 2. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to issue
19 his warrants to the persons named in this Act in the amounts
20 stated, and the treasurer of state is hereby directed to pay the
21 same from the general fund of the state of Iowa.

22 Sec. 3. The acceptance of said sums by the persons named in
23 this Act shall be in full settlement of all claims against the
24 state of Iowa growing out of the claims described.

25 Sec. 4. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall

- 1 be in full force and effect from and after its final approval
- 2 and publication in The DeWitt Observer, a newspaper
- 3 published at DeWitt, Iowa, and the Iowa Falls Citizen,
- 4 a newspaper published at Iowa Falls, Iowa.

EXPLANATION

This bill appropriates money to pay per diem for the appointive members of the capitol planning commission.
