A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the state teachers' pension.

2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

3 Section 1. Section two hundred ninety-four point fifteen

4 (294.15), Code 1966, as amended by chapter two hundred forty-

5 five (245), Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly, is

6 further amended as follows:

7 1. By striking from line twelve (12) the words "seventy-

8 five" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "one hundred".

9 2. By striking from line nineteen (19) the words "seventy-

10 five" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "one hundred".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 177

This bill would provide an increase of \$25 a month to Iowa teachers who retired before July, 1953, and served at least 25 years in the public schools. These teachers retired before Social Security was legalized for teachers and as a result do not draw Social Security for their teaching services. Most of these teachers are now in their 80's and 90's. On July 1, 1965, there were 670 drawing these retirement benefits, but the number had dwindled to 597 on January 31, 1967 and to 513 on December 31, 1968.
