## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to documents accompanying liquor shipments.
- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 3 Section 1. Section one hundred twenty-five point sixteen
- 4 (125.16), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
- 5 1. By striking from lines seven (7) and eight (8) the
- 6 words "labeled or marked" and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 7 word "identified".
- 8 2. By inserting after the word "shipper" in line eleven
- 9 (11) the following:
- 10 " , or unless such information is shown on a bill of lading
- 11 or other document accompanying the shipment".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 182

The purpose of this bill is to conform Iowa law to federal law regarding the "identifying information" which is required for alcoholic beverages being transported in interstate commerce. "Identifying information" includes the name of the consignee, the nature of the contents and the quantity.

Such "identifying information" on a bill of lading or similar document accompanying the shipment would serve all purposes previously accomplished by marking on the outside of the package, but it would save shippers considerable expense and inconvenience.

Section 125.16, Code 1966, requires placing of the "identifying information" on the "vessel or other package." This bill preserves all practical identification requirements needed by the Iowa Liquor Control Commission.
