A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to membership on the civil service commission.

2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

3 Section 1. Section three hundred sixty-five point one

4 (365.1), Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding thereto the

5 following:

6 "If such city has established, by ordinance, a human rights

7 commission, the director of the human rights commission shall

8 serve as an ex officio member of the civil service commission."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 198

The bill states that if a city has a human rights commission, its director is an ex officio member of the city's civil service commission.

1 Amend House File 198 by striking all after the enacting clause
2 and inserting in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section three hundred sixty-five point two (365.2),
4 Code of Iowa, 1966, hereby is amended by adding the following:

5 Provided, this section notwithstanding, when a human rights
6 commission has been established by any city, the director thereof
7 shall ex officio be a member, without vote, of the civil service
8 commission."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 198

10 The bill states that if a city has a human rights commission
11 its director is an ex officio member, without vote, of the city's
12 civil service commission.
