- 3 compensation, and to operate or lease concessions in or
- 4 upon property under its control.

5 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

6 Section 1. Section one hundred eleven A point four (111A.4),

7 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

8 1. By striking line ten (10) of subsection six (6), and in-

serting in lieu thereof the words "chapter. The compensation of

such assistants and employees may include the providing of suit-

able uniforms, but the salaries paid employees of the county

2 conservation board shall in no case exceed those paid".

3 2. By inserting in line one (1) of subsection eight (8),

4 after the word "To", the words "operate concessions or to lease

5 concessions and to".

## EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 21

This bill broadens the powers of county conservation boards, so as to permit them to provide uniforms to their employees as a part of the employees' compensation, and to operate or lease concessions in county conservation parks or other property under their ownership or control.

1 House File 21 is hereby amended by adding to section  
2 one (1) the following new subsection:  
3 "By inserting in line six (6) of subsection seven (7),  
4 after the word 'events', the words ', and such reasonable  
5 annual or daily fee as the board may establish for each  
6 motor vehicle entering any county conservation board park,  
7 campground, or similar area for camping purposes'."
