## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the designation of a person who may apply
- 2 for and receive aid for dependent children.
- 3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 4 Section 1. Section two hundred thirty-nine point three
- 5 (239.3). Code 1966, as amended by section two hundred eighty-
- 6 seven (287), chapter two hundred nine (209), Acts of the Sixty-
- 7 second General Assembly, is hereby further amended by inserting
- 8 in line nine (9) after the word "person" the words "or a person
- 9 eighteen years of age or older".
- 10 Sec. 2. Section two hundred thirty-nine point five (239.5),
- 11 Code 1966, as amended by section two hundred eighty-eight (288),
- 12 chapter two hundred nine (209), Acts of the Sixty-second General
- 13 Assembly, is hereby further amended by inserting in line forty-
- 14 six (46) after the word "person" the words "or a person eighteen
- 15 years of age or older".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 222

This bill permits ADC payments to a child "18 years or older" rather than the present "adult person".

SENATE AMENDMENT TO HOUSE FILE 222

1 Amend House File 22 by adding thereto the following:  
 2 "Sec. 3. Section two hundred thirty-nine point five (239.5),  
 3 Code 1966, as amended by section two hundred eighty-eight (288),  
 4 chapter two hundred nine (209), Acts of the Sixty-second General  
 5 Assembly, is hereby further amended by substituting a comma  
 6 for the period at the end of line fifty (50) and adding the following:  
 7 'except that the county board may order the assistance  
 8 payments made to another individual who is interested  
 9 in or concerned with the welfare of the child or the  
 10 person with whom the child is living when it has been  
 11 demonstrated that the person with whom the child is  
 12 living is unable to manage the assistance payments  
 13 in the best interest of the child. Such protective pay-  
 14 ments shall not be made beyond one year and shall  
 15 otherwise conform to the regulations established under  
 16 the provisions of Title IV of the Social Security Act  
 17 as amended by Public Law 90-248.'"

 4 nine (209), Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly, is hereby  
 5 amended by substituting a comma (,) for the period (.) at the end of  
 6 fifty (50) and adding the following:  
 7 "except that the county board may order the assistance payments  
 8 made to another individual who is interested in or concerned with  
 9 the welfare of the child or the person with whom the child is living  
 10 when it has been demonstrated that the person with whom the child is  
 11 living is unable to manage the assistance payments in the best  
 12 interest of the child. Such protective payments shall not be made  
 13 beyond one year and shall otherwise conform to the regulations  
 14 established under the provisions of Title IV of the Social Security  
 15 Act as amended by Public Law 90-248."
