- 1 An Act relating to the duties of members of the highway safety
- 2 patrol and the clerical staff of the department of public
- 3 safety.
- 4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 5 Section 1. Section eighty point four (80.4), Code 1966, as
- 6 amended by chapter one hundred nine (109), section one (1),
- 7 Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly, is hereby further
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 1. By striking from lines eight (8) and nine (9) the
- 10 words "inclusive of operators' and chauffeurs' license exam-
- 11 iners,".
- 12 2. By striking from line eighteen (18) the words "except
- 13 for replacement".
- 14 Sec. 2. Section eighty point eight (80.8), Code 1966, is
- 15 hereby amended by inserting in line eighteen (18) after the
- 16 word "law" the words ", except that such duties shall not be
- 17 of a clerical or administrative nature which will reduce the
- 18 effectiveness of the highway safety patrol in enforcing the
- 19 traffic laws of this state".
- 20 Sec. 3. Section eighty point nine (80.9), subsection two
- 21 (2), Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking from paragraph
- 22 b, lines five (5) and six (6), the words "to issue operators'
- 23 and chauffeurs' licenses;".
- 24 Sec. 4. Section three hundred twenty-one point one hundred
- 25 eighty-seven (321.187), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

- 1 1. By striking from line three (3) the words "highway
2 patrol" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "clerical
3 staff of the department".
- 4 2. By striking lines twelve (12) through twenty-one (21),
5 inclusive, and inserting in lieu thereof the words "to the
6 department."
- 7 Sec. 5. Section three hundred twenty-one point one hundred
8 eighty-eight (321.188), Code 1966, is hereby amended by strik-
9 ing from line one (1) the word "uniformed".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 266

This bill relieves the Iowa highway safety patrol from performing administrative and clerical duties, and specifically provides for appointment of persons from the clerical staff of the Department of Public Safety to examine applicants for operators' and chauffeurs' licenses.

- 1 Amend House File 266, page 2, by striking lines four (4)
2 through nine (9) and adding the following:
3 "2. By striking lines twelve (12) through sixteen (16) and
4 inserting in lieu thereof the words "to the department. When
5 on duty they shall wear".

Requested by Senator Clarke.

Prepared in regard to a bill for an act relating to duties of members of the highway safety patrol and clerical staff of department of public safety.

Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal as required by Rule 47: No additional cost to the State of Iowa.

Note: This bill provides for the transfer of personnel from one division within the Department of Public Safety to another. It is not asking that new personnel be hired to replace the Iowa Highway Patrol, in the testing and licensing functions.
