## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to grapes and other fruit used in making
- 2 native wines.
- 3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 4 Section 1. Section one hundred twenty-three point fifty-
- 5 six (123.56), Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking from
- 6 line six (6) the words "grown and produced in Iowa".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 276

Iowa winemakers have experienced increasing difficulty in obtaining grapes grown in Iowa for wine production. This bill removes the present statutory requirement that grapes, cherries and other fruits, and honey be grown or produced in Iowa.

- 1 Amend House File 276 by adding after page 1, line 6, the
- 2 following:
- 3 Further amend said section by adding the following new
- 4 paragraph: "For the purposes of this section 'manufacturer'
- 5 includes only those persons who process the fruit or honey,
- 6 ferment, and bottle native wines in Iowa."
