## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the use of flashing lights on motor  
2 vehicles.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point four  
5 hundred twenty-three (321.423), subsection one (1), Code  
6 1966, is hereby amended by striking from lines nine (9) and  
7 ten (10) the words "outside of the corporation limits of  
8 cities and towns".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 292

The law provides that mail carriers may use flashing white or amber lights when stopping outside of the corporate limits of any city or town. Presently, the routes of mail carriers include areas within the corporate limits of cities and towns. This bill will allow the mail carriers to use flashing lights when stopping on the streets of cities and towns.
