A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act vesting police powers and the status of peace officers
- 2 upon agents, officers, and investigators of the enforcement
- 3 division of the Iowa liquor control commission.
- 4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 5 Section 1. Section seven hundred forty-eight point three
- 6 (748.3), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
- 7 1. By inserting after subsection five (5) the following
- 8 new subsection:
- 9 "Agents, officers, and investigators of the enforcement
- 10 division of the Iowa liquor control commission."
- 11 2. By renumbering the remaining subsection.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 318

This bill will give the agents, officers, and investigators of the enforcement division of the Iowa Liquor Control Commission the authority to enforce the liquor laws of the state as peace officers.

1 Amend House File 318 by adding the following new
2 sections:
3 "Sec. 3. This act, being deemed of immediate importance,
4 shall be in full force and effect from and after its
5 publication in the Harlan Tribune, a newspaper published
6 at Harlan, Iowa, and in The Jefferson Bee, a newspaper
7 published at Jefferson, Iowa."
