A BILL FOR *Substituted for S.F. 310*

1 An Act to make appropriations to members of the Iowa commission
2 on interstate cooperation.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
5 fund of the state of Iowa to the following named persons the
6 amounts set opposite their respective names in full settle-
7 ment of all claims which they may have against the state of
8 Iowa for services rendered as a member of the Iowa commission
9 on interstate cooperation established under chapter twenty-
10 eight B (28B) of the Code:

22 Sec. 2. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to
23 issue his warrants to the persons named in this Act in the
24 amounts stated, and the treasurer is hereby directed to pay
25 the same from the general fund of the state of Iowa.

1 Sec. 3. The acceptance of said sums by the persons named
2 in this Act shall be in full acceptance of the claims
3 described.

4 Sec. 4. This Act being deemed of immediate importance
5 shall take effect and be in full force from and after
6 its publication in the Creston News-Advertiser, a newspaper
7 published in Creston, Iowa, and in the Manchester Democrat-
8 Radio, a newspaper published in Manchester, Iowa.
