A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the operation of power boats.
- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 3 Section 1. Section one hundred six point thirteen (106.13),
- 4 Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding to the end thereof the
- 5 following:
- 6 "Chapter two hundred thirty-two (232) of the Code shall
- 7 have no application in the prosecution of offenses committed
- 8 in violation of this chapter or rules and regulations which
- 9 are adopted under the authority of this chapter which are
- 10 punishable by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars
- 11 or by imprisonment for not more than thirty days."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 329

In the past, it has been impossible to prosecute juveniles committing boating offenses without going through the juvenile courts. This bill will place the prosecution of boating violations in the same category as motor vehicle violations.
