A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the renewal fees for certificates of regis-
- 2 tration of professional engineers and land surveyors.
- 3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 4 Section 1. Section one hundred fourteen point eighteen
- 5 (114.18), Code 1966, as amended by chapter one hundred fifty
- 6 (150), section two (2), Acts of the Sixty-second General
- 7 Assembly, is further amended as follows:
- 8 1. By striking from line twenty-one (21) the word "two"
- 9 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "four".
- 10 2. By striking lines twenty-five (25) through thirty-four
- 11 (34), inclusive, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 12 "twenty dollars. For the duration of any period of required
- 13 active military service for the United States the board may,
- 14 at its discretion, exempt a registrant from renewal fees, with-
- 15 out penalty, which may have become due from registered profes-
- 16 sional engineers and land surveyors and may renew such certifi-
- 17 cates without penalty."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 353

The purpose of this bill is to make it clear that only professional engineers and land surveyors called to active military service may have their certificates renewed by the board without fees or penalty. The penalty for delayed renewal is increased to conform to a previous enactment doubling the renewal fee.

- 1 Amend House File 353 by striking all of lines ten
- 2 (10) through seventeen (17).
