A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the state printing department and public
- 2 printing.
- 3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 4 Section 1. Section fifteen point five (15.5), Code 1966,
- 5 is hereby amended by striking from line two (2) the word
- 6 "twenty" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty".
- 7 Sec. 2. Section fifteen point twenty-nine (15.29), Code
- 8 1966, is hereby amended by inserting in line ten (10) after
- 9 the word "thousand" the words "five hundred".
- 10 Sec. 3. Section fifteen point forty-two (15.42), Code
- 11 1966, is hereby amended by striking from lines fourteen (14)
- 12 and fifteen (15) the words "without the approval of the state
- 13 superintendent of printing".
- 14 Sec. 4. Section sixteen point eight (16.8), Code 1966,
- 15 is hereby amended by striking from lines six (6), seven (7),
- 16 and eight (8) the words "head of the department from which
- 17 the documents were issued," and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 18 words "executive council".
- 19 Sec. 5. Section seventeen point twenty-seven (17.27), Code
- 20 1966, is hereby amended by striking from line fourteen (14)
- 21 the words "fifty cents" and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 22 words "one dollar".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 354

This bill was requested by the Superintendent of Printing. It raises the per diem pay of the lay members of the Printing Board; changes the

amount on bid contracts from \$1,000 to \$1,500; also makes some other corrections on the operation of the Printing Board and raises from 50 cents to \$1.00 for reprints before any charges are made by the state.

1 Amend House File 354 by striking everything after the
2 enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3 Section 1. Section fifteen point seven (15.7), Code
4 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

5 1. By striking lines one (1) and two (2) and inserting
6 in lieu thereof the words "As used in chapters fifteen (15),
7 sixteen (16), and seventeen (17), 'printing' means the repro-
8 duction of an image from a printing surface made generally by
9 a contact impression that causes a transfer of ink or the
10 reproduction of an impression by a photographic process and".

11 2. By adding at the end thereof the following new para-
12 graph:

13 "For the purposes of this chapter, the reproduction of
14 ten or more copies from one original on any convenience office
15 copier is printing and shall not be permitted without the
16 approval of the superintendent of printing."

17 Sec. 2. Section fifteen point twenty-nine (15.29), Code
18 1966, is hereby amended by striking from line ten (10) the word
19 "one" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "two".

20 Sec. 3. Section fifteen point thirty-seven (15.37), Code
21 1966, as amended by chapter ninety (90), section one (1), Acts
22 of the Sixty-second General Assembly, is hereby repealed and
23 the following enacted in lieu thereof:

24 "All printing presses, except such presses owned by the
25 auditor of state and purchased pursuant to the provisions of
26 chapter seventy-three (73), Acts of the Sixty-third General
27 Assembly, First Session, and other printing equipment owned by
28 the state and in the possession of any department, commission,
29 agency, or board shall be centralized in a state building in
30 the city of Des Moines under the control of the state printing
31 board.

32 All office copiers and other duplicating equipment owned
33 by or in the possession of executive and judicial departments,
34 commissions, agencies, or boards shall be under the jurisdiction
35 of the state printing board. The board may lease or purchase
36 such duplicating machines as are necessary for each of the
37 departments with funds from the state printing board revolving
38 fund and assess the costs of operating such duplicating machines
39 to the appropriate department."

40 Sec. 4. Section fifteen point forty-two (15.42), Code 1966,
41 is hereby repealed.

42 Sec. 5. Section seventeen point three (17.3), Code 1966,
43 as amended by chapter two hundred nine (209), section twenty-
44 five (25), Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly, and
45 chapter sixty-nine (69), section sixty (60), Acts of the Sixty-
46 third General Assembly, First Session, is hereby further amended
47 by adding at the end thereof the following new paragraph:

48 "The officials and departments required by this section to
49 file reports shall submit the reports on standardized forms
50 furnished by the state comptroller. All officials and agencies

51 submitting reports shall consult with the state comptroller and
52 the director of the office of planning and programming, and shall
53 devise standardized report forms for submission to the governor
54 and members of the general assembly."

55 Sec. 6. Section seventeen point twenty (17.20), Code 1966,
56 as amended by chapter three hundred forty-two (342), section ten
57 (10), Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly, is hereby amended
58 by striking all of subsection four (4).

59 Sec. 7. Section seventeen point twenty-seven (17.27), Code
60 1966, is hereby amended by striking from line fourteen (14) the
61 words "fifty cents" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "one
62 dollar".

63 Sec. 8. Section fifteen point five (15.5), Code 1966, is
64 hereby amended by striking from line two (2) the word "twenty"
65 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty".

EXPLANATION OF AMENDMENT

1 This bill (1) redefines "printing"; (2) increases the
2 dollar limit of printing over which Printing Board approval
3 is required from \$1,000 to \$2,000; (3) places all convenience
4 office copiers and reproduction units of executive and
5 judicial departments in Des Moines under the jurisdiction of
6 the State Printing Board; (4) provides for the standardization
7 of reports made by state departments; (5) repeals the provisions
8 which require the publication of the Annual Proceedings of the
9 Iowa Academy of Science; (6) increases the fifty cent limit on
10 publications that must be sold to one dollar; and (7) increases
11 the pay of the Printing Board for their per diem allowance from
12 twenty to thirty dollars per day.

1 Amend the committee on state government amendment to House

2 File 354, filed February 4, 1970, as follows:

3 1. Line 15 by inserting after the word "copier" the
4 following: "located in the city of Des Moines".

5 2. Line 29 by inserting after the word "board" the
6 following: "located in the city of Des Moines".

7 3. Line 34 by inserting after the word "boards" the
8 following: "located in the city of Des Moines".
