A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act to authorize the commissioner of the department of
- 2 social services to operate facilities at locations away
- 3 from institutional campuses.
- 4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 5 Section 1. Section two hundred eighteen point one (218.1),
- 6 Code 1966, as amended by chapter one hundred ninety-nine (199)
- 7 and chapter two hundred nine (209), Acts of the Sixty-second
- 8 General Assembly, is hereby amended by adding the following
- 9 two subsections:
- 10 "Camps."
- 11 "Other facilities not attached to the campus of the main
- 12 institution as program developments require."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 389

This bill will authorize the commissioner to build and operate facilities away from institutional campuses. The primary reason for this bill is the establishing of forest camps for juvenile offenders, but there might be other facilities needed in the future which this bill would also cover. I would point out that no buildings are built unless the legislature appropriates the money for them; and the individual construction projects are always given to the legislature so that they know what they are appropriating capital improvements funds for. This bill in itself would not permit the building of buildings unless the legislature made an appropriation for it. I think you are aware that both the Governor and the commissioner are committed to establishing at least one and perhaps two forest camps during this biennium, if legislature can see fit to appropriate money for them.
