A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate money credited to the account of the
2 state of Iowa in the unemployment trust fund.
3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the funds
5 made available to this state under section nine hundred three
6 (903) of the Social Security Act, as amended, the sum of seven
7 hundred thirty thousand one hundred eighty-two dollars and
8 sixty cents, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be
9 used, under the direction of the Iowa employment security
10 commission, subject to the approval of the executive council
11 of the state, for the erection of a building or buildings, and
12 for such improvements, facilities paving, landscaping, fur-
13 nishings, and fixed equipment as may be required for the use
14 of the Iowa employment security commission in the performance
15 of its functions under chapter ninety-six (96), Code of 1966.
16 Sec. 2. No part of the money hereby appropriated may be
17 obligated after June 30, 1971.
18 Sec. 3. The amount obligated pursuant to this Act during
19 any twelve-month period beginning on July first and ending on
20 the following June thirtieth shall not exceed the amount by
21 which the aggregate of the amounts credited to the account of
22 this state pursuant to section nine hundred three (903) of the
23 Social Security Act during such twelve-month period and the
24 fourteen preceding twelve-month periods exceeds the aggregate
25 of the amounts obligated for administration and paid out for

1 benefits and charged against the amounts credited to the
2 account of this state during such fifteen twelve-month periods.

3 Sec. 4. Section ninety-six point nine (96.9), subsection
4 four (4), Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

5 1. By striking from paragraph a, line thirty-two (32),
6 the word "four" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "four-
7 teen".

8 2. By striking from paragraph a, line thirty-seven (37),
9 the word "five" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fif-
10 teen".

11 3. By striking from paragraph b, line twelve (12), the
12 word "fourth" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "four-
13 tenth".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 605

Title IX of the Federal Social Security Act makes funds collected under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA) available for administration of the employment security program. Such funds are often referred to as "Reed Act funds." This bill concerns the use of "Reed Act funds" as are transferred to the account of the State of Iowa in the Unemployment Trust Fund of the United States Treasury under section 903 of Title IX, Federal Social Security Act. "Reed Act funds" may be used for erection of a building, improvements (*but not remodeling*), facilities, paving, landscaping, furnishings, and fixed equipment (*but not office equipment*). Of the \$730,182.60 referred to in this bill, \$332,160.94 will expire June 30, 1971, if not appropriated and obligated. *No state general funds or IPERS funds are requested in this bill.*
