A BILL FOR

*Passed House per
Senate amendment 5-21,
72-36.*

- 1 An Act to provide for the distribution of income, corporation,
- 2 and sales taxes, and making an appropriation therefor.
- 3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 4 Section 1. Section four hundred twenty-two point sixty-two
- 5 (422.62), Code 1966, as amended by chapter three hundred forty-
- 6 eight (348), section fifty (50), Acts of the Sixty-second Gen-
- 7 eral Assembly, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in
- 8 lieu thereof:
- 9 "1. All fees, taxes, interest, and penalties imposed under
- 10 this chapter shall be paid to the department of revenue in the
- 11 form of remittances payable to the state treasurer and the de-
- 12 partment of revenue shall transmit each payment daily to the
- 13 state treasurer.
- 14 2. The amount of the proceeds of the additional tax imposed
- 15 by section four hundred twenty-two point five (422.5), subsec-
- 16 tion six (6) of the Code, shall be certified by the director to
- 17 the state treasurer and the amount thereof withdrawn and cred-
- 18 ited to a permanent fund hereby created in the office of the
- 19 state treasurer to be known as the 'moneys and credits tax re-
- 20 placement fund'.
- 21 3. Annually on November first of each year, the state
- 22 treasurer shall transfer one million two hundred thousand
- 23 dollars to the division of motor vehicle registration of the
- 24 department of public safety, for the purpose of purchasing
- 25 supplies and materials, and for the cost of manufacture of

1 motor vehicle registration plates at the prison industries.
2 If only one plate is authorized by law, the amount transferred
3 shall be eight hundred thousand dollars. All motor vehicle
4 registration plates shall be treated with a reflective material
5 according to specifications prescribed by the commissioner of
6 public safety. On October thirty-first of each year, the un-
7 expended balance of the funds transferred to the department of
8 public safety for license plates shall be transferred to the
9 road use tax fund.

10 4. For the purpose of procuring reflective plates, an addi-
11 tional fee of twenty-five cents per year for each registration
12 of a motor vehicle, collected at the time of registration, shall
13 be added to the registration fee. The additional fee shall be
14 credited to the road use tax fund.

15 5. Unless otherwise provided the fees, taxes, interest, and
16 penalties collected under this chapter shall, for the first three
17 quarters of each fiscal year, be credited to the general fund.

18 6. During the last quarter of each fiscal year an amount
19 equal to ten percent of the net receipts from two-thirds of
20 the sales taxes collected under division four (IV) of this
21 chapter for the fiscal year, less the amount transferred during
22 such fiscal year for motor vehicle registration plates and, for
23 the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June 30, 1971
24 only, the amount appropriated by the general assembly for drivers'
25 training aid under the provisions of chapter three hundred twenty-
26 one (321) of the Code, shall be transferred to the road use tax
27 fund created by section three hundred twelve point one (312.1)
28 of the Code. The remainder shall be credited to the general
29 fund."

30 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twelve point one (312.1),
31 subsection four (4), is hereby amended by striking from lines
32 two (2), three (3), and four (4) the words "equal to ten per-
33 cent of the net revenues collected under division four (IV)
34 of said chapter" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "as
35 defined by section four hundred twenty-two point sixty-two

1 (422.62) of the Code”.

2 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated from the general
3 fund of the state to the department of public instruction for
4 each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending
5 June 30, 1971, the following amounts, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, to be used for the purposes designated.

7 1. DRIVERS' TRAINING

8 For drivers' training aid to such school districts of the
9 state as qualify under provisions of chapter three hundred
10 twenty-one (321) of the Code.....\$1,700,000.00

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 659

The purpose of this bill is to clarify section 422.62 of the Code and in addition, it provides for reimbursement for expenditures for the drivers' education program from ten percent of two-thirds of the receipts during the last quarter year of sales tax funds scheduled for the road use tax fund. The appropriation carries out the provisions of subsection 6 of section 1.

1 1. Amend House File 659 by striking from page 2, lines 22,
2 23, 24, 25 and 26, the following "and, for the biennium
3 beginning July 1, 1969, and ending June 30, 1971 only,
4 the amount appropriated by the General Assembly for
5 driver's training aid under the provisions of Chapter
6 three hundred twenty-one (321) of the Code."
