A BILL FOR

1 An Act to add two categories to the milk adulteration categor-
2 ies; to add such categories to the unlawful milk definition,
3 and to provide for additional testing authority and correct
4 certain existing testing standards.

5 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

6 Section 1. Section one hundred ninety point four (190.4),
7 Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
8 two new subsections:

9 "If obtained from a cow which has consumed chemical,
10 medicinal, or radioactive agents capable of being secreted in
11 milk.

12 If obtained from a cow in a mastitic condition."

13 Sec. 2. Section one hundred ninety-four point four (194.4),
14 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

15 1. By inserting in line fifteen (15) after the word "deter-
16 ioration" the words ", or which contains matter evidencing pro-
17 duction from a mastitic cow; or which contains chemicals, medi-
18 cines, or radioactive agents deleterious to health".

19 2. By adding thereto the following:

20 "At least four times in every six-month period a test shall
21 be made of each producer's milk to determine the existence of
22 evidence of production from mastitic cows. The secretary shall
23 determine and promulgate the standards and methods of testing
24 the milk for this purpose being guided by recommendations or
25 regulations established by federal agencies regulating in this

1 field.”

2 Sec. 3. Section one hundred ninety-four point six (194.6),

3 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

4 1. By striking lines six (6) through eight (8), inclusive,

5 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 “approved test for that purpose, except that testing shall
7 be done in an officially designated laboratory at least once
8 every thirty days where a standard plate count or an equiva-
9 lent plate counting procedure is used.”

10 2. By inserting in line sixteen (16) after the word

11 “count” the words “(standard plate count or equivalent)”.

12 Sec. 4. Section one hundred ninety-four point nine (194.9),

13 Code 1966, is hereby amended by inserting in line five (5)

14 after the word “million” the words “, or which contains mater-

15 ial evidencing production from a mastitic cow; or which con-

16 tains chemicals, medicines, or radioactive agents deleterious

17 to health.”

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 666

This bill is corrective and clarifying in that it adds to section 190.4 of the Code, two additional descriptive milk adulteration categories and then adds to chapter 194 authority to promulgate rules for testing for matter indicating production from mastitic cows which is not presently covered by chapter 194. In addition, it extends the definition of “unlawful milk” provided in section 194.9.
