A BILL FOR

1 An Act to establish a permanent revolving fund for the state
2 printing board to pay the costs of the centralized printing
3 department and to make an appropriation therefor.

4 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

5 Secion 1. Section fifteen point thirty-six (15.36), Code
6 1966, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new
7 paragraphs:

8 "There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the
9 state to the state printing board the sum of seventy-five thou-
10 sand (75,000) dollars to establish a permanent revolving fund.
11 This fund may be used in supplying paper stock, offset printing,
12 copy preparation, binding, and original payment of printing
13 and binding claims for any of the state departments, bureaus,
14 commissions or institutions. All salaries and expenses properly
15 chargeable thereto shall be paid from said fund. The state
16 superintendent of printing may, with the approval of the
17 printing board and the executive council, also use said fund
18 for the purchase of replacement or additional equipment, if a
19 sufficient balance will remain in said fund which will enable
20 the continued operation of the centralized printing department.

21 The state superintendent of printing shall periodically
22 render a statement to each state department, bureau, commission
23 or institution for the cost of paper stock, offset printing,
24 copy preparation or binding supplied thereto. Such expense
25 shall be paid by the state departments, bureaus, commissions

1 or institutions in the same manner as other expenses of
2 such departments are paid, and such sum shall be credited
3 to the centralized printing revolving fund. If a surplus
4 accrues to said revolving fund for which there is no antici-
5 pated need or use, the governor shall order such surplus
6 turned over to the general fund of the state.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 695

This bill establishes a revolving fund for use of the state superintendent of printing subject to the approval of the state printing board or executive council.
