## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to liquid transport carrier fees.
- 2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 3 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-seven A point
- 4 nineteen (327A.19), Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking
- 5 all of line seven (7) after the word "dollars" and lines
- 6 eight (8) through ten (10), inclusive, and inserting in lieu
- 7 thereof the following:
- 8 " , except that the fee for a tractor or truck-tractor
- 9 shall be fifteen dollars, and except that the fee herein pro-
- 10 vided shall not be imposed on any trailer or semitrailer."

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 758

This bill imposes an annual fee of fifteen dollars on each tractor or truck-tractor. The bill also removes the present annual fee of six dollars for each trailer or semitrailer. No change is made in the annual fee of five dollars on each truck. The revenue-producing effect will remain substantially the same, but the proposed amendment will provide a more suitable assessment, consistent with the industry practice of interchanging equipment.

Prepared in regard to House File 758, a bill for an act relating to liquid transport carrier fees.

Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative proposal as required by Rule 47:

House File 758 transfers the liquid transport carrier fee from approximately 2,800 trailers to approximately 1,100 tractors. The fee has been computed so that there is no anticipated increase in revenue from these fees.
