## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act to establish the composition of the General Assembly
- 2 and provide for election of the members thereof.
- 3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*
- 4 Section 1. The membership of the General Assembly is hereby
- 5 fixed at fifty senators and one hundred representatives. The
- 6 General Assembly hereby declares that in establishing districts
- 7 to be represented by senators and representatives serving in
- 8 the Sixty-fourth General Assembly, to hold office from January
- 9 11, 1971 until January 8, 1973, it adheres to the following
- 10 principles:
- 11 1. Each senator and each representative shall represent a
- 12 single-member district.
- 13 2. Each house shall be apportioned on the basis of popula-
- 14 tion as shown by the 1960 United States decennial census. Dis-
- 15 tricts shall be of substantially equal population and shall be
- 16 of compact and contiguous territory, as required by the Consti-
- 17 tution of the state of Iowa and the Constitution of the United
- 18 States.
- 19 3. Each senatorial district shall consist of two entire
- 20 representative districts.
- 21 4. No voting precinct shall be divided in forming a district.
- 22 5. District boundaries shall follow county boundaries wher-
- 23 ever possible, subject to constitutional requirements and the
- 24 other principles stated in this section.
- 25 6. Wherever possible, senators shall be permitted to com-

1 plete the terms for which they were elected. Any senator who  
2 was elected in 1968 for a four-year term, and who is the only  
3 senator residing in any senatorial district established by  
4 this Act, shall be permitted to complete his term. If two or  
5 more senators reside in any one senatorial district established  
6 by this Act, that district shall elect a senator in the 1970  
7 elections and the terms of any such senators shall be shortened  
8 if necessary to permit such election.

9 Sec. 2. As used in this Act, unless otherwise specifically  
10 stated:

11 1. Any reference to a specific township means the civil  
12 township so identified as the boundaries of such township ex-  
13 isted on January 1, 1969.

14 2. Any reference to a specific city or town means the city  
15 or town so identified as the corporate limits of such city or  
16 town existed on January 1, 1969.

17 3. Any reference to a specific ward or precinct means:

18 a. With respect to the city of Ames, the ward or precinct  
19 so identified as such ward or precinct is established by ordi-  
20 nance two thousand one hundred seventy-three (2173), adopted  
21 February 7, 1967.

22 b. With respect to the city of Burlington, the ward or pre-  
23 cinct so identified as such ward or precinct is established by  
24 chapter seven (7) of the Burlington city code as amended to  
25 February 17, 1969.

26 c. With respect to the city of Cedar Rapids, the ward or  
27 precinct so identified as such ward or precinct is established  
28 by section two point zero (2.02) of the Cedar Rapids city code,  
29 as amended to January 1, 1969.

30 d. With respect to the city of Clinton, the ward or pre-  
31 cinct so identified as such ward or precinct is established by  
32 chapter one thousand two hundred eighty-four (1284), Clinton  
33 city ordinances, adopted October 9, 1967.

34 e. With respect to the city of Council Bluffs, the precinct  
35 so identified as such precinct is established by ordinance three

1 thousand six hundred ninety-three (3693), adopted August 24,  
2 1964, as amended by ordinance three thousand eight hundred one  
3 (3801), adopted July 17, 1967.

4 f. With respect to the city of Davenport:

5 (1) The ward so identified as such ward is established by  
6 ordinance two (2), municipal code of the city of Davenport  
7 (1957), as amended to March 19, 1969.

8 (2) The precinct so identified as such precinct is estab-  
9 lished by ordinance three (3), municipal code of the city of  
10 Davenport, as amended to March 19, 1969.

11 g. With respect to the city of Des Moines, the ward or pre-  
12 cinct so identified as such ward or precinct is established by  
13 sections seventeen dash ten (17-10) through seventeen dash  
14 eighty-seven (17-87), inclusive, municipal code of the city of  
15 Des Moines (1962), as amended to July 1, 1968.

16 h. With respect to the city of Dubuque, the precinct so  
17 identified as such precinct is established by ordinance seven  
18 dash sixty-nine (7-69), adopted February 17, 1969.

19 i. With respect to the city of Fort Dodge, the precinct  
20 so identified as such precinct is established by ordinance  
21 one thousand two hundred fifty-one (1251), adopted April 11,  
22 1967.

23 j. With respect to the city of Iowa City, the ward or pre-  
24 cinct so identified as such ward or precinct is established by  
25 ordinance two thousand three hundred eighty-one (2381), adopted  
26 March 15, 1966, as amended by ordinance two thousand four hun-  
27 dred twenty-seven (2427), adopted March 27, 1967.

28 k. With respect to the city of Mason City, the ward or pre-  
29 cinct so identified as such ward or precinct is established by  
30 title one (1), chapter six (6), 1966 city code of the city of  
31 Mason City, as amended by ordinance one thousand seventy-five  
32 (1075), adopted February 17, 1969.

33 l. With respect to the city of Ottumwa, the precinct so  
34 identified as such precinct is established by ordinance two  
35 thousand twelve (2012), adopted August 9, 1965.

1 m. With respect to the city of Sioux City, the precinct  
2 so identified as such precinct is established by ordinance S  
3 dash three hundred eighty (S-380), adopted April 1, 1963, as  
4 amended by ordinance S dash four thousand four hundred twenty  
5 (S-4420), adopted March 29, 1965 and by ordinance S dash eight  
6 thousand three hundred twenty-eight (S-8328), adopted December  
7 12, 1966.

8 n. With respect to the city of Waterloo, the ward or pre-  
9 cinct so identified as such ward or precinct is established by  
10 ordinance one thousand eight hundred (1800), ordinances of the  
11 city of Waterloo, as amended to January 1, 1969.

12 Sec. 3. The membership of the senate and house of repre-  
13 sentatives in the Sixty-fourth General Assembly, to hold office  
14 from January 11, 1971 until January 8, 1973, shall be deter-  
15 mined as follows:

16 1. Each representative district established by section  
17 four (4) of this Act shall elect one representative in 1970.

18 2. Each senatorial district established by section five  
19 (5) of this Act in which no incumbent senator resides, or in  
20 which no senator elected in 1968 resides, shall elect one  
21 senator in 1970.

22 3. Each senatorial district established by section five  
23 (5) of this Act in which only one incumbent senator resides  
24 shall be represented in the Sixty-fourth General Assembly by  
25 that senator, if he was elected in 1968 to a four-year term  
26 or was subsequently elected to complete the unexpired portion  
27 of a four-year term which began in January, 1969.

28 4. Each senatorial district established by section five  
29 (5) of this Act in which two or more incumbent senators reside  
30 shall elect one senator in 1970. The terms of office of the  
31 senators living in any such district who were elected to a  
32 four-year term in 1968, or were subsequently elected to com-  
33 plete the unexpired portion of a four-year term which began  
34 in January, 1969, shall be terminated effective January 11,  
35 1971.

- 1     Sec. 4. The state is hereby divided into one hundred  
2 representative districts, as follows:
- 3     1. The first representative district shall consist of:
- 4     a. In Lyon county, Sioux, Larchwood, Allison, Centennial,  
5 Logan, Cleveland, Lyon, Richland, Doon, Garfield, and Wheeler  
6 townships.
- 7     b. In Sioux county, Settlers, Sioux, Rock, Lincoln, Sheridan,  
8 Grant, Garfield, Plato, Welcome, Capel, Lynn, Buncombe, Eagle,  
9 Center, West Branch, Holland, Floyd, and Logan townships, and  
10 that portion of the city of Orange City lying within Nassau  
11 township.
- 12    2. The second representative district shall consist of:
- 13    a. All of Plymouth county.
- 14    b. In Sioux county, Washington, Reading, Sherman, and  
15 East Orange townships and that portion of Nassau township  
16 lying outside the corporate limits of the city of Orange City.
- 17    3. The third representative district shall consist of:
- 18    a. All of Dickinson county.
- 19    b. In Lyon county, Riverside, Midland, Elgin, Rock, Liberal,  
20 Grant, and Dale townships.
- 21    c. All of Osceola county.
- 22    4. The fourth representative district shall consist of:
- 23    a. In Clay county, Waterford, Summit, Meadow, Lone Tree,  
24 Riverton, Spencer, and Sioux townships.
- 25    b. In O'Brien county, Floyd, Franklin, Lincoln, Hartley,  
26 Carroll, Summit, Center, Omega, Baker, Dale, Highland, Caledonia,  
27 Union, and Liberty townships.
- 28    5. The fifth representative district shall consist of:
- 29    a. All of Emmett county.
- 30    b. In Kossuth county, Eagle, Grant, Springfield, Hebron,  
31 Swea, Harrison, Ledyard, Lincoln, Seneca, Greenwood, Ramsey,  
32 German, Fenton, Burt, Portland, and Buffalo townships.
- 33    6. The sixth representative district shall consist of:
- 34    a. In Kossuth county, Lotts Creek, Union, Plum Creek,  
35 Wesley, Whittemore, Algona, Cresco, Irvington, Prairie,

- 1 Garfield, Riverdale, Sherman, and Luverne townships.
- 2 b. All of Palo Alto county.
- 3 7. The seventh representative district shall consist of:
- 4 a. In Cerro Gordo county, Grant, Lincoln, Lime Creek, and
- 5 Falls townships.
- 6 b. All of Winnebago county.
- 7 c. All of Worth county.
- 8 8. The eighth representative district shall consist of:
- 9 a. All of Hancock county.
- 10 b. In Wright county, Boone, Norway, Belmond, Pleasant,
- 11 Liberty, Lake, Grant, Iowa, Dayton, Lincoln, and Blaine town-
- 12 ships.
- 13 9. The ninth representative district shall consist of:
- 14 a. In Floyd county, Cedar, Niles, St. Charles, and Charles
- 15 City townships.
- 16 b. All of Mitchell county.
- 17 10. The tenth representative district shall consist of:
- 18 a. All of Butler county.
- 19 b. In Floyd county, Rock Grove, Rudd, Floyd, Rockford,
- 20 Ulster, Scott, Union, Pleasant Grove, and Riverton townships.
- 21 11. The eleventh representative district shall consist of:
- 22 a. In Chickasaw county, Deerfield, Washington, Jacksonville,
- 23 Utica, Dayton, New Hampton, and Stapleton townships.
- 24 b. All of Howard county.
- 25 c. In Winneshiek county, Fremont, Orleans, Lincoln, Sumner,
- 26 Calmar, Jackson, and Washington townships.
- 27 12. The twelfth representative district shall consist of:
- 28 a. All of Bremer county.
- 29 b. In Chickasaw county, Chickasaw, Bradford, Richland,
- 30 Dresden, and Fredericksburg townships.
- 31 13. The thirteenth representative district shall consist of:
- 32 a. In Allamakee county, Waterloo, Union City, Iowa, Hanover,
- 33 French Creek, Lansing, Union Prairie, Makee, Center, Lafayette,
- 34 Ludlow, and Jefferson townships.
- 35 b. In Winneshiek county, Burr Oak, Hesper, Highland, Bluffton,

1 Canoe, Pleasant, Madison, Decorah, Glenwood, Springfield,  
2 Frankville, Military, and Bloomfield townships.

3 15. The fourteenth representative district shall consist of:

4 a. In Allamakee county, Paint Creek, Taylor, Post, Franklin,  
5 Linton, and Fairview townships.

6 b. All of Clayton county.

7 15. The fifteenth representative district shall consist of:

8 a. All of Buena Vista county.

9 b. In Clay county, Lake, Freeman, Clay, Lincoln, Gillett  
10 Grove, Logan, Peterson, Douglas, Herdland, and Garfield town-  
11 ships.

12 c. In O'Brien county, Grant and Waterman townships.

13 16. The sixteenth representative district shall consist of:

14 a. All of Humboldt county.

15 b. All of Pocahontas county.

16 17. The seventeenth representative district shall consist

17 of that portion of the city of Mason City composed of wards one  
18 (1), two (2), and three (3), and precinct one (1) of ward four  
19 (4),

20 18. The eighteenth representative district shall consist of:

21 a. The following portions of Cerro Gordo county: Lake, Mason,  
22 Portland, Union, Clear Lake City, Geneseo, Clear Lake, Mount  
23 Vernon, Bath, Owen, Grimes, Pleasant Valley, and Dougherty town-  
24 ships, and that portion of the city of Mason City composed of  
25 precinct two (2) of ward four (4).

26 b. In Franklin county, Wisner, Richland, Ross, West Fork,  
27 Marion, Mott, Clinton, and Washington townships.

28 19. The nineteenth representative district shall consist of  
29 all of Fayette county.

30 20. The twentieth representative district shall consist of:

31 a. All of Buchanan county.

32 b. In Delaware county, Richland, Honey Creek, Coffins Grove,  
33 Prairie, Milo, Adams, and Hazel Green townships.

34 21. The twenty-first representative district shall consist  
35 of that portion of the city of Sioux City composed of pre-

1 cincts one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4), five (5), six  
2 (6), seven (7), eight (8), and thirty-one (31).

3 22. The twenty-second representative district shall consist  
4 of that portion of the city of Sioux City composed of precincts  
5 nine (9), eleven (11), thirteen (13), fourteen (14), sixteen  
6 (16), seventeen (17), eighteen (18), nineteen (19), thirty (30),  
7 thirty-two (32), and thirty-three (33).

8 23. The twenty-third representative district shall consist  
9 of that portion of the city of Sioux City composed of precincts  
10 ten (10), twelve (12), twenty-two (22), twenty-three (23),  
11 twenty-four (24), twenty-five (25), twenty-six (26), twenty-  
12 seven (27), twenty-eight (28), and twenty-nine (29).

13 24. The twenty-fourth representative district shall consist  
14 of:

15 a. That portion of the city of Sioux City composed of pre-  
16 cincts fifteen (15), twenty (20), twenty-one (21), and thirty-  
17 four (34).

18 b. All of Woodbury county outside the city of Sioux City.

19 25. The twenty-fifth representative district shall consist  
20 of:

21 a. All of Cherokee county.

22 b. All of Ida county.

23 26. The twenty-sixth representative district shall consist  
24 of:

25 a. In Calhoun county, Williams, Butler, Sherman, Garfield,  
26 Twin Lakes, Center, Elm Grove, Lake Creek, Logan, Jackson, Lake  
27 City, Calhoun, and Union townships.

28 b. All of Sac county.

29 27. The twenty-seventh representative district shall con-  
30 sist of:

31 a. In Carroll county, Wheatland, Kniest, Arcadia, Maple  
32 River, Washington, Roselle, Pleasant Valley, Ewoldt, Warren,  
33 Eden, and Newton townships.

34 b. All of Crawford county.

35 28. The twenty-eighth representative district shall con-

1 sist of:

2 a. In Carroll county, Sheridan, Jasper, Carroll, Grant,  
3 Glidden, Richland, and Union townships.

4 b. All of Greene county.

5 29. The twenty-ninth representative district shall consist  
6 of:

7 a. In Calhoun county, Lincoln, Greenfield, Cedar, and  
8 Reading townships.

9 b. In Webster county outside the city of Fort Dodge, Jackson,  
10 Deer Creek, Badger, Newark, Johnson, Douglas, Cooper, Colfax,  
11 Fulton, Elkhorn, Pleasant Valley, Otho, Washington, Roland, Clay,  
12 Burnside, Sumner, Webster, Gowrie, Lost Grove, Dayton, Yell, and  
13 Hardin townships.

28 a. In Black Hawk county outside the cities of Cedar Falls  
29 and Waterloo, Union, Washington, Mt. Vernon, Cedar Falls, and  
30 Black Hawk townships.

31 b. All of the city of Cedar Falls.

32 38. The thirty-eighth representative district shall con-  
33 sist of that portion of the city of Waterloo composed of ward  
34 one (1) exclusive of precinct five (5) thereof, and ward three  
35 (3) exclusive of precinct seven (7) thereof.

- 28 b. That portion of the city of Cedar Rapids composed of  
29 precincts fourteen (14), fifteen (15), twenty (20), twenty-six  
30 (26), twenty-seven (27), thirty-two (32), thirty-three (33),  
31 and thirty-six (36).
- 32 44. The forty-fourth representative district shall con-

25 49. The forty-ninth representative district shall consist

27 a. In Dubuque county outside the city of Dubuque, Liberty,  
28 Concord, Jefferson, Peru, New Wine, Iowa, Center, Dubuque,  
29 Dodge, Taylor, and Vernon townships.

30 b. That portion of the city of Dubuque composed of pre-  
31 cincts eleven (11), twelve (12), thirteen (13), and seventeen  
32 (17).

33 50. The fiftieth representative district shall consist of  
34 that portion of the city of Dubuque composed of precincts three  
35 (3), four (4), seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), ten (10), four-

1 teen (14), and fifteen (15).

2 51. The fifty-first representative district shall consist  
3 of:

4 a. In Dubuque county outside the city of Dubuque, Table  
5 Mound, Mosalem, Cascade, Whitewater, Prairie Creek, and Wash-  
6 ington townships.

7 b. That portion of the city of Dubuque composed of precincts  
8 one (1), two (2), five (5), six (6), and sixteen (16).

9 52. The fifty-second representative district shall consist  
10 of:

11 a. All of Jackson county.

12 b. In Jones county, Richland, Washington, Scotch Grove,  
13 Clay, Madison, Wyoming, Hale, and Oxford townships.

14 53. The fifty-third representative district shall consist  
15 of:

16 a. In Harrison county, Little Sioux, Jackson, Allen, Lin-  
17 coln, Morgan, Raglan, Magnolia, Boyer, Clay, Taylor, Calhoun,  
18 Jefferson, Cass, Cincinnati, St. John's, La Grange, Union, and  
19 Washington townships.

33 57. The fifty-seventh representative district shall con-  
34 sist of:

35 a. In Polk county outside the city of Des Moines, Crocker,

1 Elkhart, Jefferson, Lincoln, Madison, Union, and Webster town-  
2 ships. For the purposes of this Act, Webster township shall be  
3 deemed to include those portions of sections twenty-five (25),  
4 twenty-six (26), twenty-seven (27), twenty-eight (28), twenty-  
5 nine (29), and thirty (30), township seventy-nine (79) north,  
6 range twenty-five (25) west, which constituted the voting pre-  
7 cinct designated as "Walnut four (4)" of Polk county for the  
8 1968 primary and general elections.

#### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 781

This bill establishes the senatorial and representative districts for the Sixty-fourth General Assembly in the manner recommended by the Legislative Apportionment Commission. The districts represented by present members of the Legislature are retained on a standby basis until the end of 1970, for use in any necessary special elections to fill vacancies in the Sixty-third General Assembly, but will have no application to the 1970 primary or general elections.

Although the districts established by this bill are identical with those recommended by the Apportionment Commission, the numbering of individual districts has been changed from that used in the Commission's final report. Therefore, the following list is provided to facilitate use of the Commission's report in connection with this bill.

#### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 781

This bill establishes the senatorial and representative districts for the Sixty-fourth General Assembly in the manner recommended by the Legislative Apportionment Commission. The districts represented by present members of the Legislature are retained on a standby basis until the end of 1970, for use in any necessary special elections to fill vacancies in the Sixty-third General Assembly, but will have no application to the 1970 primary or general elections.

Although the districts established by this bill are identical with those recommended by the Apportionment Commission, the numbering of individual districts has been changed from that used in the Commission's final report. Therefore, the following list is provided to facilitate use of the Commission's report in connection with this bill.

### EXPLANATION OF VOTE ON HOUSE FILE 781

The undersigned Democratic members, the Minority Party of the Sixty-third General Assembly in the Iowa House of Representatives, voted "no" on the final passage of House File 781 for the following reasons:

1. We unanimously supported the Commission Plan, a plan that cost the taxpayers of the State of Iowa approximately \$25,000.00, a plan that had been drafted by a fourteen (14) member bi-partisan commission pursuant to House Joint Resolution 1 and Senate Joint Resolution 5, a plan that we believed had a chance of meeting Constitutional guidelines, a plan that the Majority Party had led us to believe would be adopted without substantive change and a plan that had been represented to be just and equitable to all of the citizens of Iowa.

2. House File 781 contained numerous amendments on final passage that were contrary to Constitutional guidelines in that it did:

- a) Contain variances between the districts which were avoidable.
- b) Contain variances out of the regard for the integrity of county lines, the compactness of districts and Republican, political motivation.

Finally, House File 781 on final passage as amended did not represent a good faith effort to achieve precise mathematical equality and was not the best plan of "equal representation for equal numbers of people" available to the Iowa House of Representatives.

3. The Nelson, et al., amendment which became part of the bill on passage created the only district in the entire State of Iowa under 26,000 population resulting in an increase variance between the districts and whereas the Commission Plan was fair and equitable to Sioux City and Woodbury County, the amended plan created the smallest district in Iowa for purely political reasons.

The substantive changes incorporated by amendment to House File 781 were sponsored by an ad hoc committee consisting of one Republican member from each Congressional district. We strongly oppose this procedure as being strictly arbitrary and partisan.
