A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to watchmakers and repairmen.

2 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

3 Section 1. Section one hundred twenty point three (120.3),

4 subsection two (2), Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking

5 from line seventeen (17) the word "ten" and inserting in lieu

6 thereof the word "thirty".

7 Sec. 2. Section one hundred twenty point six (120.6),

8 Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking from line seven (7)

9 the word "ten" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "twenty".

10 Sec. 3. Section one hundred twenty point seven (120.7),

11 Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking from line nineteen

12 (19) the word "five" and inserting in lieu thereof the word

13 "ten".

14 Sec. 4. Section one hundred twenty point eight (120.8),

15 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

16 1. By striking from subsection two (2), line four (4)

17 the word "ten" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifteen".

18 2. By striking from subsection two (2), line twenty-one

19 (21) the word "ten" and inserting in lieu thereof the word

20 "fifteen".

21 3. By striking from subsection three (3), line seven (7)

22 the word "five" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "ten".

23 4. By striking from subsection four (4), line eight (8)

24 the word "five" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "ten".

25 Sec. 5. Section one hundred twenty point nine (120.9),

1 Code 1966, is hereby amended as follows:

2 1. By striking from line sixteen (16) the words "one dollar"
3 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "five dollars".

4 2. By striking from lines eighteen (18) and nineteen (19)
5 the words "one dollar" and inserting in lieu thereof the words
6 "five dollars".

7 Sec. 6. Section one hundred twenty point eleven (120.11),
8 Code 1966, is hereby amended by striking from line five (5)
9 the words "one dollar" and inserting in lieu thereof the words
10 "two dollars".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 785

This bill would increase the per diem compensation of members of the watchmakers' board from ten to thirty dollars and would increase the fees charged for watchmakers' examinations.

This bill also changes the fee for registration of a watchmaker who is not a resident of this state from ten dollars to fifteen dollars; the registration of a watchmaker who is a resident of the state of Iowa from five dollars to ten dollars; the renewal fee of a watchmaker who is a resident of the state of Iowa from five dollars to ten dollars; the registration of an apprentice watchmaker from one dollar to five dollars; the renewal of a registration for an apprentice watchmaker from one dollar to five dollars and the issuance of a duplicate certificate from one dollar to two dollars.

This bill to raise the fees for registration of watchmakers is necessary if the Board of Watchmaker Examiners is to receive enough funds from fees to operate without a state appropriation.
