**EXPLANATION OF AMENDMENT  
TO HOUSE FILE 793**

By Alt, Renda, Ellsworth

This amendment increases the salary of the three liquor control commissioners commensurate with other salary adjustments and increases being granted in this bill. The amendment would increase the annual salary from 12 to 14 thousand for each commisisoner.

We are giving the following salary increases:

Alcoholism director .....	\$2,300
Auditor of state .....	2,000
Comptroller of state .....	2,000
Employment security commissioner .....	1,000
Secretary of the executive council .....	2,000
Curator of history and archives .....	1,500
Insurance commissioner .....	1,000
Insurance commisisoner .....	1,000
Commissioner of labor .....	1,000
Law librarian .....	2,000
Medical librarian .....	2,000
Superintendent of printing .....	1,500
Real estate director .....	2,000
Secretary of state .....	2,000
Treasurer of state .....	2,000

It does not seem just or logical in this appropriation bill not to increase the salary of the liquor commissioners. If we do not adopt the amendment, it will mean that we have not given the commission a salary adjustment for a period of at least four years when we know the cost of living has gone up greatly since they were last given a salary adjustment.

If any group of administrators is entitled to a raise or indeed entitled and of necessity should be well paid, it is the Iowa Liquor control commissioners. They are fund raisers as a part of their duties. Competent administrators can mean additional revenue to the state of Iowa. They are charged with running a 65-million-dollar business for the state of Iowa. Their job is highly sensitive to public criticism. They are charged with the responsibility of operating almost 200 liquor stores, have approximately 800 employees, are charged with broad responsibilities of liquor law enforcement, and must be immune to those activities which could bring scandal to the operation of the state monopoly in the distribution and sale of liquor.

Our liquor control commissioners are underpaid when their individual salaries are compared to their responsibilities and to those commissioners of other states. To attract good administrators to the job, keep them dedicated, honest, and interested in doing the best job for the state on a continuing basis, they should be adequately compensated.

Under the circumstances, to continue the present salary of \$12,000 per year for another two years would be grossly unfair and inadequate.
