A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from moneys received by the Iowa aeronautics
2 commission.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. For the Iowa aeronautics commission there is
5 hereby appropriated all funds received under authority of
6 chapter three hundred twenty-eight (328) of the Code for the
7 biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June 30, 1971.

8 The following amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
9 is authorized to be expended from said receipts for each
10 year of the biennium to be used in the manner designated:

11 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment
12 and miscellaneous purposes\$226,370.00

13 Sec. 2. The remainder of the fund is hereby appropriated
14 for contingencies arising during the biennium which are legally
15 payable from the funds and for aid for local airport projects
16 and improvements.

17 Sec. 3. A contingency shall exclude any purpose or project
18 which was presented to the general assembly by way of a bill
19 and which failed to become enacted into law, however, for the
20 purpose of this Act a necessity of additional operating funds
21 may be construed as a contingency.

22 Sec. 4. Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act
23 shall be allocated for contingencies it shall be determined by
24 the governor and the state comptroller that a contingency
25 exists and that the proposed allocation shall be for the best

- 1 interest of the state.
- 2 Sec. 5. If the full amount authorized is not expended during
- 3 the first year, the unused portion shall carry forward and be
- 4 an addition to the amount authorized for the second year of
- 5 the biennium.
- 6 Sec. 6. The provisions of chapter eight (8) of the Code
- 7 shall apply to this Act.
- 8 Sec. 7. Where any of the laws of this state are in conflict
- 9 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
- 10 biennium.
