A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate moneys received by the state banking
2 department.

3 *Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

4 Section 1. For the state banking department there is
5 hereby appropriated all funds received under authority of
6 chapter five hundred twenty-four (524) of the Code, or
7 any successor thereto, for the biennium beginning July 1,
8 1969 and ending June 30, 1971. The following amount, or
9 so much thereof as may be necessary, is authorized to be
10 expended from said receipts for each year of the biennium
11 to be used in the manner designated:

12 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment, and
13 miscellaneous purposes\$987,428.50

14 Sec. 2. The remainder of the funds referred to in section
15 one (1) of this Act is hereby appropriated for contingencies
16 arising during the biennium which are legally payable from
17 said fund.

18 Sec. 3. A contingency shall exclude any purpose or project
19 which was presented to the general assembly by way of a bill
20 and failed to become enacted into law, however, for the purpose
21 of this Act a necessity of additional operating funds may be
22 construed as a contingency.

23 Sec. 4. Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act
24 shall be allocated or contingencies it shall be determined
25 by the executive council that a contingency exists and that

- 1 the proposed allocation shall be for the best interest of
- 2 the state.
- 3 Sec. 5. If the full amount authorized in section one
- 4 (1) is not expended during the first year, the unused portion
- 5 shall carry forward and be an addition to the amount authorized
- 6 for the second year of the biennium.
- 7 Sec. 6. The provisions of chapter eight (8) of the Code,
- 8 are hereby made a part of this Act.
- 9 Sec. 7. Where any of the laws of this state are in conflict
- 10 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for
- 11 the biennium.
